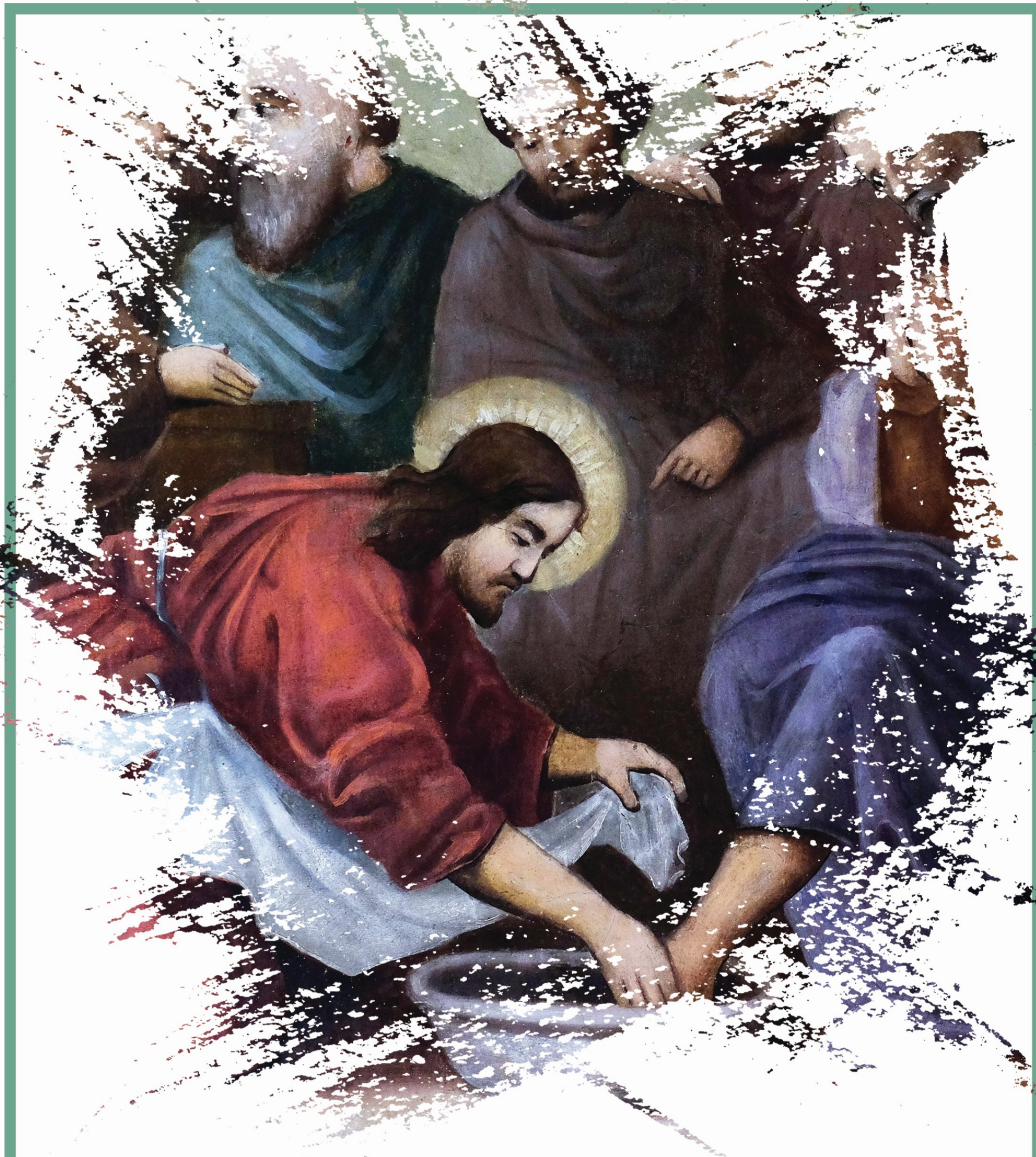

Class meets October 24!

Today our children explored the Gospel reading about James and John asking to sit at Jesus' right and left in Heaven. Next week we hear the story of Jesus healing the blind Bartimaeus.

St Paul of the Cross – Oct. 20

Paolo Francesco Danei was the oldest son in a poor but noble Italian family. After a year in the Venetian army, he returned to a monk-like life of prayer and penance and refused to marry. In a vision in 1720, Our Lady, wearing a black habit with a white cross and bearing Jesus' name, told Paul to start an order to preach Christ's passion. With his bishop's approval, he founded the Discalced Clerks of the Most Holy Cross and Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ, which he led for the rest of his life, and later began a nuns' institute. Passionists were soon doing missions, retreats and spiritual direction throughout Italy. Paul was canonized in 1867.

The Grace of Forgiveness in-person retreat Oct. 23

"The Grace of Forgiveness: Forgiving Ourselves, Others and God" is a daylong program open to men and women who wish to grow in their relationship with God, improve the quality of their relationships with others, and live a more peaceful and serene life. The presentation will include what forgiveness is and is NOT; our human need for and experiences of forgiveness; reasons why people often find forgiveness difficult, and suggestions for moving into a fuller Christian life characterized by a forgiving heart. The day will include three major sessions: exploring issues related to forgiving ourselves, forgiving others, and forgiving God. Each of these sessions will include time for personal prayer and reflection as well as opportunities for small-group sharing. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available in the afternoon. The in-person program will take place from 9 a.m.–4 p.m. in the Mount Saint Joseph Auditorium, 8001 Cummings Road, Maple Mount (12 miles west of Owensboro on Hwy. 56). Participants are invited to remain on campus for a 4:30 p.m. Saturday vigil Mass in the Motherhouse Chapel. The program facilitator will be Sister Cheryl Clemons, OSU, a certified spiritual director. Sister Cheryl has been offering retreats, parish missions, and RCIA programs for over 25 years. The \$40 fee includes lunch. 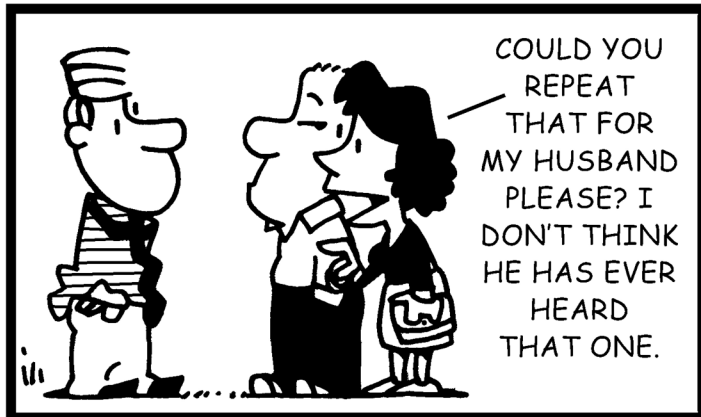
