

The Need for More Power

Every winter at Freedoms Foundation there is at least one storm that knocks out the power. It happens at least once a summer too. When an ice storm hit in 2014, a group of 5th graders from California were on



campus and had to be moved to a hotel. Because this is such a regular occurrence, Freedoms Foundation hopes to install three back-up generators, one each for the dormitories. The Americanism Project's goal for 2018—2019 is to raise enough money to purchase a natural gas powered back-up generator for the MacArthur Building, which will allow heat and electricity to operate normally in the kitchen,

dining room, classroom, game room, lounge, and 15 dorm rooms when power is out.
