Fire Safety:

In the event of a fire, there is one street access exit and a fire escape to the back alley directly behind 437 Boylston Street. The Spot has two fire exits and a fire escape directly outside one of these exits. We have a fire extinguisher on hand as well as smoke detectors, alarms, and emergency lights. In case of emergency, exit the building quickly in an orderly fashion using the stairs and exit the building. A representative will be carrying and waving an orange flag letting everyone know where to gather. Detailed emergency evacuation procedures are listed throughout The Spot and are read to the audience just prior to show time.

Parking

The Spot does not provide parking and is not liable for any parking fees or tickets.

Metered street parking is available on surrounding streets. Meters run from 8am-8pm with a maximum 2 hours of parking. \$1.25 per hour. Dollars, Quarters, Visa and MasterCard are accepted. Transportation/Directions

Transportation from Logan Airport

From the Boston Logan International Airport (1 Harborside Drive Boston, MA 02128) head southeast. After 0.7 mi make a slight right and continue for 325 feet then make a slight left (signs for Massachusetts 1A S/I-93 N/Sumner Tunnel/Massachusetts 1A N/Revere). Take the ramp to MA-1A. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Massachusetts 1A S/Interstate 93 N/Sumner Tunnel and merge onto MA-1A S. Turn left to stay on MA-1A S (Toll Road). Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Massachusetts 3 N/Storrow Drive. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for MA-28 S/MA-3 N/Storrow Drive and merge onto MA-3 N/MA-3A N. Continue onto MA-28 S (signs for Storrow Drive 3). Take the Beacon Street exit on the left toward Copley Square/Back Bay. Turn left onto Beacon St. right on Arlington Street, right onto Providence Street, right onto Berkeley Street and right on to Boylston Street and The Spot will be on the left.

Driving Directions from North

Take i-95 south (toward Boston) Take exit 26 for Massachusetts 3 N toward Massachusetts 28 S/Storrow Drive. Merge onto mA-3 north/mA-3A north. Continue onto MA 28 south (signs toward Storrow drive west). Take the beacon street exit on the left toward Copley square/back bay. Turn left on to Beacon Street, then right onto Arlington. Then turn right onto Providence Street, then right onto Berkeley Street then right onto Boylston Street. The Spot is located between Au bon pain and Starbucks.

Driving Directions from South

Take I-95 North. Take exit 12 for I-93 North toward Boston. Take exit 18 for Frontage Road toward Mass Ave. /Roxbury. Merge onto I-93 Frontage Road. Make a slight right to stay on I-93 Frontage Road. Turn left onto w 4th street/Dover Street. Continue onto Berkeley Street. Then turn right onto Boylston. The spot is located between au bon pain and Starbucks.

Driving Directions from West

Take I-90 East toward New Hampshire/Maine/Boston. Take exit 22 toward the Prudential Center and Copley Square. Turn right onto Stuart Street then turn left onto Berkeley Street. Then turn right onto Boylston Street. The Spot is located between Au Bon Pain and Starbucks.

Transportation by Subway

Red Line: Take Red Line to Park Street Station, switch to Green Line (outbound) and get off at Arlington. Exit to the left toward Boylston St. and Public Gardens and continue on Boylston St. The Spot is located between Starbucks/Century Bank and Au Bon Pain. You have gone too far if you cross Berkeley St.

Blue Line: Switch to Green Line at Government Center Station, head Outbound and get off at Arlington. Exit to the left toward Boylston St. and Public Gardens and continue on Boylston St. The Spot is located between Starbucks/Century Bank and Au Bon Pain. You have gone too far if you cross Berkeley St.

Orange Line: Take Orange line to Back Bay station, exit toward Dartmouth Street, continue on Dartmouth Street then turn right onto Boylston Street. The Spot is located a short distance from the intersections of Berkeley and Boylston.

Green Line: Take Green Line to Arlington. Exit to the left toward Boylston St. and Public Gardens and continue on Boylston St. The Spot is located between Starbucks/Century Bank and Au Bon Pain. If you cross Berkeley St, you have gone too far.

Box Office

- No advance ticket sales unless specifically arranged in advance by management.
- Guest list extremely limited and must be advanced.
- Tickets are available for purchase day of show at The Spot's box office (437 Boylston Street, 3rd Floor). The Box Office opens 30 minutes prior to show time. Cash only.
- If needed, there are ATM's located on Boylston Street within a five block radius: Citizens Bank, TD Bank, Bank of America, and Century Bank.

Rules and Regulations

- The Spot is an all ages venue.
- Doors open 30 minutes before show time in most cases.
- Re-Entry is permitted unless otherwise noted.
- Pyro-technics are NOT allowed under any circumstances! This includes but is not limited to: fog machines, dry ice, smoke machines, flames and all products of that nature.
- No weapons which include but are not limited to: guns, knives, pocket knives, razor blades and laser pointers.
- Smoking is not allowed anywhere inside of the building.
- No moshing allowed.
- Absolutely no drugs or alcohol are allowed inside the building.
- There is no outside food or drink allowed inside of The Spot unless otherwise noted.
- Pets of any kind are not allowed in The Spot. Allowances will ONLY be made for registered service animals.

Features for Patrons with Disabilities

Accommodations can be made for any patron with disabilities; we ask that you please contact The Spot staff with any requests within 24 hours prior to your arrival.

Mobility Impairments:

The Spot is accessible by elevator for patrons with disabilities. The entrance to the building is at sidewalk level. We also have a wheel chair accessible bathroom (door width: 33", height: 82")

Sight Impairments:

All rooms and bathrooms within The Spot have braille signage located either on the doors to the rooms or on the left or right sides of the doors. In case of emergency, there are two emergency stairways with hand railings.

Hearing Impairments:

A registered sign language interpreter can be arranged for any patron who requires a translator.

Medical Disabilities:

Please notify The Spot staff upon entry if you or a friend is susceptible to epileptic seizures, as strobe lights and loud noises may occur during the event.
