College students currently receiving a scholarship or grant award from the ERP need to submit a certified college transcript and Form E. Transcripts and form must be submitted to the Church office by 5 PM on May 19, 2017.

Late applications are discouraged due to limited funds and the high need for college financial assistance. Late applications will be penalized and subject to reduced or no funding.

Announcement of individuals selected to receive the monetary and non-monetary awards will be made at the 11:00 AM service on Sunday, June 11, 2017.

Again, all applications are due back in the Church office by 5 PM on May 19, 2017!!

Trinity Church is blessed and we are committed to the task of financially assisting our members who demonstrate a need for monetary resources.

Trinity Missionary Baptist Church firmly believes in the development of the spiritual and intellectual abilities of every member. We therefore promote higher education for the entire membership. The pursuit of higher education is one that we passionately embrace and encourage for the intellectual empowerment of our church family. We, therefore, deem it important to recognize members who achieve academic excellence, including graduating high school students and members seeking graduate or post-graduate degrees.

The Education Recognition Committee administers the application and award process. All candidates for any recognition must submit an application through the committee's application process.

The program has two elements of recognition: (1) monetary scholarships and grants; and, (2) a non-monetary "Pastor's Award for Academic Excellence". **All monetary awards are need based**; however, the non-monetary "**Dr. Robert E. Bailey Award for Academic Excellence**" recognizes our top scholar.

More specific information on the program, including how to apply, is contained in the attached application package. In order to be considered for any element of the program, it is important that all materials are returned by the **May 19, 2017 deadline**. **Applications received after May 19, 2017 will be considered, if time and funds are still available.** I trust you will understand the importance of responding in a timely manner to noted deadlines.

The announcement of the individuals selected for receipt of the Scholarships, Grants and Award of Academic Excellence will be made on Sunday, **June 11, 2017** during the 11:00 AM service. Recipients are expected to be in attendance for acceptance of monetary awards. All applicants for the Dr. Robert E. Bailey Award for Academic Excellence will be introduced to the congregation during the **June 11, 2017** service and the award recipients will be announced at that time.



EDUCATION RECOGNITION PROGRAM

SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS & AWARD for ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- **SCHOLARSHIPS** are available for those with ≥ 3.0 GPA AND demonstrated financial need; includes undergraduate, graduate, and trade school candidates.
- **GRANTS** are available for those with ≥ 2.3 GPA AND demonstrated financial need; includes undergraduate, graduate, and trade school candidates.
- An **AWARD FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE** is available for the top scholar with a GPA of 3.0 or better and demonstrated church participation.
- All scholarships, grants, and excellence awards require applicants to submit application information through the Education Recognition Committee application process.
- Active church participation and stewardship are key criteria for all candidates.
- For scholarships and grants, applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- **Deadlines must be observed; applications are due by May 19, 2017.**
- Recipients will be announced on **Sunday, June 11, 2017 during the 11:00 AM worship service.**



SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET BEFORE ANY APPLICATION CAN BE PROCESSED:

1. The applicant must be a member of Trinity Missionary Baptist Church.
2. The applicant must be active in church for at least 2 years prior to receiving a scholarship. (*“Active”* means attending worship service on a regular basis and belonging to at least one church auxiliary. This requires consistent attendance, active participation in the auxiliary and being dependable in fulfilling other obligations set by the auxiliary.)
3. GRADES – The applicant **MUST** have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or greater. The applicant **MUST** demonstrate financial need.
4. Applicant, or the parent(s) or guardian(s) of an applicant, must sign a release of information form which will allow the school to release the applicant’s transcript. A current “official copy” transcript must be attached to the application when it is turned into the church office.
5. For applicants that are claimed as dependents, the parents(s) of the applicant must submit a financial statement for the previous year. This includes either a W-2 Form or a tax statement (Form 1040 or 1040A). Financial statements of both parents, if applicable, must be attached to the application when it is turned into the church office.
6. Independent (*indicates that you are not claimed as a dependent by another adult worker*) employed applicants must submit a financial statement for the previous year. This includes either a W-2 Form or a tax statement (Form 1040 or 1040A). For independent applicants, your parents are not required to submit financial information.
7. The applicant must submit two (2) character reference letters.
8. The applicant must submit a resume.
9. All applicants will be interviewed as part of the application process.



GRANT REQUIREMENTS

THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET BEFORE ANY APPLICATION CAN BE PROCESSED:

1. The applicant must be a member of Trinity Missionary Baptist Church.
2. The applicant must be active in church for at least 2 years prior to receiving a scholarship. ("Active" means attending worship service on a regular basis and belonging to at least one church auxiliary. This requires consistent attendance, active participation in the auxiliary and being dependable in fulfilling other obligations set by the auxiliary.)
3. GRADES – The applicant MUST have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.3 - 2.99. The applicant MUST demonstrate financial need.
4. Applicant, or the parent(s) or guardian(s) of an applicant, must sign a release of information form which will allow the school to release the applicant's transcript. A current "official copy" transcript must be attached to the application when it is turned into the church office.
5. For applicants that are claimed as dependents, the parents(s) of the applicant must submit a financial statement for the previous year. This includes either a W-2 Form or a tax statement (Form 1040 or 1040A). Financial statements of both parents, if applicable, must be attached to the application when it is turned into the church office.
6. Independent (*indicates that you are not claimed as a dependent by another adult worker*) employed applicants must submit a financial statement for the previous year. This includes either a W-2 Form or a tax statement (Form 1040 or 1040A). For independent applicants, your parents are not required to submit financial information.
7. The applicant must submit two (2) character reference letters.
8. The applicant must submit a resume.
9. All applicants will be interviewed as part of the application process.



SCHOLARSHIP & GRANT CHECKLIST

- Confirm that church auxiliary president(s)/Sunday school teacher(s) have submitted verification forms (**Form B**).
- Submit completed application package (Forms A, B and C) by the required **May 19, 2017** due date. (Packages received after **May 19, 2017** will be reviewed, if time and funds are still available).
- Receive phone call or email from the Education Recognition Committee indicating your interview time and/or to request additional information for review in the application process.
- Complete interview (**Applicants must be on time!**)
