WELCOME

The Raymond Sutton family extends a warm welcome to you for our 68th annual Quarter Horse production sale. We believe it is the oldest Quarter Horse production sale in the world.

/ Je are a working ranch that raises horses, cattle and bison. Yearly income is from our livestock and we take our breeding programs very seriously. Our family has been raising superior quality horses and cattle for over a century. In 2001, we joined the elite list of the first 48 breeders to receive the AQHA Legacy Award for 50 continuous years of raising Quarter Horses. This year we will register our 2921th foal. During the ninety odd years we have been in the registered livestock business, our programs have had constant breed improvement as their foremost goal. It is our philosophy that a controlled bloodline-breeding program makes dominant breeders with distinctive carry-on breeding ability. Although we have outcrosses, our program has maintained good, solid foundation lines that have that carry-on ability.

When someone mentions a Sutton bred horse, the bloodlines have proven themselves over and over. We are very proud that our select band of mares and stallion battery are among the top in the nation. CD Cut the Lights was 7th in AQHA Year-end standings for All Age Stallions in tiedown roping. The World Champion Palomino Youth 14-18 Barrel Horse

and the PRCA Barrel Horse of the Year were both purchased as weanlings in our sale. Solid Gold Edition tied for 5th in year-end standings for AQHA Senior Stallions. The produce of Miss Winning Gal was first in AQHA Produce of Dam. Bill's Rock tied for 1st in AQHA Get-of-Sire standings for 2 years; Barnone Impressive was 3rd. Patty Punk tied for 1st in AQHA Produce of Dam and Peggy Note was 1st. Our breeding program is not a fluke but something developed over years of careful matings and constant scrutiny.

Our goal is horses with superior dispositions, intelligence, conformation, and ability. We strive to produce horses that excel in looks and can perform in a number of disciplines. In 2017 the ranch had horses qualified for the World Show in Heeling, Calf Roping, Amateur Cutting, Junior Working Cowhorse, and Ranch Riding. This year we have horses that qualified for the AQHA Versatility Finals, Level 1 boxing, Aged Stallions at the Select, Open, and Amateur World.

Toals run in hundreds of acres on our river pastures until the sale. They are strong, fit, and agile. The natural conditions allow the foals to develop bone structure, heart and lungs, and the muscular system. Research shows that the broader and more varied the types of exercise the young horse receives, the more overall body strength and soundness the foal develops. The large pastures give the developing foals physical and mental experiences that develop overall body strength and athletic ability.

This can greatly increase the young horse's chances of long term superior performance.

ur stallion battery and mare band carry some of the best foundation and modern breeding to be found. The offspring are equally at home in the show ring or rodeo arena, doing ranch work, or as a family friend. They don't have to be bucked out or ridden miles before they become dependable! The number of customers that return year after year to buy our horses is testimony to the success of our breeding program. It is not unusual for a customer to call wanting foals to replace horses gotten from us that are getting a little aged. The horses will be on display for you Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning. This will give you plenty of time to look over anything you might be interested in. Before sale day if you wish to stop by the ranch and look over the offering let us know when you are coming, we are always happy to have you see our herds.

In the many years we have been raising livestock, we have gained a respected reputation for fair dealing and standing behind what we sell. We value the trust people like you have in us and will continue to serve you as best we can.



He sired AQHA and AYQHA Champions, Superior and ROMs, race point earners and World Show Finalists.

His get follow the success of their

He earned the title by being High Point Reining, Calf Roping, Novice Cutting and Reserve Open Cutting and Halter Horse. Few horses can claim to be this versatile. He sired AQHA Superiors, World finalists, ROMs. Where he is most outstanding is through the produce of his daughters.

He was the son of the immortal Scooter S and carried Silver King, Midnight, and Old Joe Bailey Blood. Scooter S was a leading sire of show ROMs and Maternal Grandsires of AQHA Champions. He sired Superior Cutting, Barrel Racing, Reining, Calf Roping and Halter horses, World Champion and High Point Horses as well as numerous AQHA Champions.

High Impression was a grandson who had a very limited show career due to an injury but was first in AQHA Produce of Dam. His half brother, Tuff Rock, had halter, performance, and year-end-award honors. RWS Sokota Joe is a great-grandson.

Rapid D Or started his show career in the right way by being Grand Champion Stallion at the National Western in Denver. 

She was sired by Skip Tres Bar (2x Skipper W) and he had both halter and performance points. Teddy Rio halter points, a son of Pretty Buck. PE 219 AQHA points.

COMING 2020

We added three new stallions to our breeding program this year.

Cookin Merada NRCHA LTE \$128,623 - When we lost The Love Man we looked for a replacement that had similar genetics. "Cookie's" sire, Meradas Money Talks (, LTE \$47,894:5th NCHA Open Derby, 5th Steamboat Springs Cutting 4-Year-Old Open Derby; 4th El Cid 3-Year-Old Futurity Open; 4th Diamond B 3-Year-Old Futurity Open; finalist in the Memphis 4-Year-Old Open Futurity. He is a Leading Sire. Sire of money-earners, \$2,623,734, earners of 2,848 AQHA points. His grandsire, Freckles Merada x Money Talks Rio x Doc Quixote earned \$106,900 with PE \$3,069,586 Cookie's" dam, Cookies Cookin (Doc's Hickory x Smart Foxy x Smart Little Lena), ranks in the Top Ten on the NRCHA All-Time Leading Producer list. "Cookie" was third at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity, fourth at the Southwest RCHA Summer Classic, and won



the NRCHA Circle Y Ranch Derby Championship. In the APHA he has earned 49 reining and 59 working cowhorse points and was 3 X World Champion Reined Cowhorse, 1X World Champion Reining, and 1X Reserve World Champion Reining. He has 30 AQHA performance points and a Register of Merit. When we bought him he had only 15 AQHA foals and 24 APHA foals. At the 2018 APHA World Show his son, Peptos Smart Cookie, repeated his sire's win as Champion Jr Working Cowhorse and recently won the cow work at 2019 NRCHA Derby.

Wimpys Hi Roller – We are bound for the Select World, the Open and Amateur World with this new addition to our stallion battery. As of August 1, he was 2nd in AQHA Senior Aged Stallions. His sire, Wimpys Little Step LTE \$185, 757 - just became the third \$11 million sire in the NRHA. His offspring have over 9,000 AQHA points. He was NRHA Open Futurity champion; congress Open Reining Futurity champion. He has sired NRHA Open Futurity and Derby champions, Hall of Fame horses and AQHA point earners. He is a leading maternal grand sire of dams whose produce have earnings of over \$1,700,000 and include a World Champion Junior Working Cow Horse. His dam, Spooks Melody, NCHA LTE \$34,106, NRHA PE \$29,964. She is a daughter of Grays Starlight LTE \$41,128 –PE \$12, 606.672 and AQHA Pts 6,599. With Maxi Lena (Doc O Lena, 2X King) and Lynx Melody(NCHA Hall of Fame) as her grandparents on the maternal side.



Playboy Peppy Elvis – "Elvis" is one of the last breeding sons of Freckles Playboy LTE \$60,015; 25 AQHA Points; AQHA World Champion Junior Cutting Horse. On the Leading Sire List. PE \$28,700,970, earners of 10,092 AQHA points. He is a full brother to , Zipa Freckles NCHA LTE \$110,000. Elvis came from Buster Welch's (rode Mr San Peppy and many others to their championships) breeding program. His dam, Litten Lena by Peppy San Badger, produced many of the futurity colts for Buster and Greg. He has never seen the bright lights of the arena but at 15'3 with muscle and bone to burn he definitely turns heads.

TERMS OF SALE

Terms of the sale are cash in United States currency payable immediately after the sale unless other arrangements have been made prior to the sale. Checks will be considered cash. If you are unable to attend the sale, you may mail your bids or telephone your bids sale day. Any buyer wishing to transact business in this manner is requested to provide a letter of credit at least three days prior to the sale. The sale day telephone number is 605-264-5452.

After being sold, the sellers will handle the horses to the best of their ability, but assume no further liability for their safekeeping. Any expenses incurred after the gavel falls shall be the sole responsibility of the buyer. Buyers who will not be removing horses within 24 hours must make arrangements for their care until they can be removed. Horses not removed in a timely manner will be charged \$3 per day care. A charge of 1-1/2% per month will be charged on any outstanding amounts due. The entire amount is due within 6 month after the sale date or the horse will be repossessed.

Any person attending this sale does so at their own risk. Neither the Suttons or any other person connected with this sale assumes any liability, legal or otherwise.

WARRANTIES

All known defects will be printed in the catalog or called when the horse enters the ring and announced before sold. Any problem with a horse must be reported to the seller within one week of the sale. Announcements from the auction block will take precedence over the catalog. There is no breeding soundness guarantee on foals sold. Any veterinarian expenses incurred after the horse is sold are the sole responsibility of the buyer.

BREEDERS INFORMATION

The buyer will be furnished with all necessary papers to transfer purchases. The buyer will pay the APHA or

AQHA transfer fee and this will be added to the purchase price. The AQHA and APHA have adopted a member/nonmember fee schedule for registration and transfers. Membership information for both associations will be available sale day and all buyers will be charged the member price.

Registration papers will be held until checks clear the bank. When the check has cleared, the registration papers along with transfer and the fees will be sent to the AQHA/APHA and transferred to the name of the buyer. Buyers should be prepared to give the exact name and membership number to the sale clerk that they want on the registration certificate when they settle up for their purchases.

FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE

- All foals are well halter broken.
 All foals were dewormed in August.
- All horses have their Coggins Test and are ready for shipment to the 50 states and Canada.
- A veterinarian will be on the grounds sale day for necessary interstate certificates, etc.
- For international shipment, arrangements can be made for a federal veterinary inspection.
- If you live more than 500 miles from us, delivery to a central point may be a possibility - check with us before sale day.
- If you are planning to haul just one weanling we suggest that you bring an older horse as a babysitter on the way home!


ACCOMMODATIONS


