**RESOLUTION NO. 16-07**

**APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MONTGOMERY  
COUNTY SHERIFF FOR POLICE SERVICES THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018**

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The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio met in regular session on the 5th day of January, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township offices, located at One Business Park Drive, Dayton, with the following members present:

Trustee Johnson moved for the adoption of the following resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees is desirous of providing adequate police protection for the property and residents of Jefferson Township, and

**WHEREAS**, the Montgomery County Sheriff has the authority pursuant to Section 311.29 of the Ohio Revised Code to enter into a contract with the Township to provide police protection in the unincorporated area of Jefferson Township, and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 505.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Township has the authority to enter into a contract with the Montgomery County Sheriff for police protection

**WHEREAS**, The Jefferson Township Board of Trustees and the Montgomery County Sheriff are desirous of entering into an agreement to provide police protection to the residents and property of Jefferson Township, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, during the term of the agreement,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees approves intergovernmental agreement with the Montgomery County Sheriff for police protection in Jefferson Township

Section 1. The Township Administrator is authorized to execute said agreement

Section 2. The agreement shall commence on January 1, 2016 and shall terminate on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2018.

Section 3. Said agreement may be terminated by either party, upon ninety (90) days advance written notice.

Section 4. The Sheriff shall present a monthly statement to the township identifying the actual expenses incurred in providing said services, which shall be payable to the sheriff's

Policing Revolving Fund. The payment to the Sheriff shall not exceed the amount collected from the Jefferson Township Police Levy on an annual basis.

Trustee McGuire seconded the motion, and the roll was called on the question of its adoption. The vote was as follows:
