The message on Sunday morning really convicted me to "Serve the Lord with Joy and Gladness and Enter into his gates with Thanksgiving. Then the pastor said, "How about, "instead of thinking about being thankful during Thanksgiving, we just develop a lifestyle of "Thanks Living". This means every day of the year we are thankful. I'm not really sure I like it when the pastor is only speaking to me... Oh I forgot, I am the Pastor. Well I still don't like it. I'm going to have to have a talk with him.

While I'm not crazy about this quarantine, I am so blessed and thankful. The Lord is so good, and although things don't always go my way, I'm going to keep praising the Lord for all he has done, including going to the cross so that I might receive his Love, Grace and Mercy. Halleluiah!
