The History of the Edmund Kells – Richard A. Grennie American Legion Post No. 316

I have been a member of Post 316 since 1992. From1993 – 1996 I served as a Vice-Commander. In 1997 I was elected to the position of Commander. I also served as Commander from 2003 – 2005. Through the coming years I continued to be active with the Post .I also served as a Vice Commander with Richmond County and as the membership chairman for the county.

In 2014 I became the historian for the Post, but really did not do to that much. In 2015 our Post was having problems maintaining our building monetarily and after discussing the issues about what we could do the only thing left was to sell the building. It was a sad day when that had taken place at a meeting in May 2015. It was then that I realized that all the events that had taken place in this building for more than seventy years would possibly be not remembered and lost.

Then I took on the responsibility as the Post Historian a little more seriously and I began going through old files, letters and minutes from past years. I began retyping hand written minutes from many past years. I did find out that sometime in the late sixties there was fire in the attic and a

lot of files and photos were lost. I contacted Department of New York and received a lot of help from them. We began taking down photos and certificates that were hanging on the walls for many years and scanned them all. I created a website and placed all the information on it in different categories.

My next step was to make a slideshow video of all the photos and listed all the past commanders since the beginning of Post 316. All this basically had taken about a year and now the slideshow video is online and on DVD. I will continue to add material as it happens. Please visit our website at

Our membership now holds our meetings at the New Dorp Moravian Church which is located at 1250 Todt Hill Road.

Directions are available on our website and **following this message**. The meetings are held on **the third Monday** at 7:30 P.M.

Join us at our meetings and be part of something you can be proud of. Have some coffee or a soft drink and a bite to eat after the meeting. You might see some old friends or have a chance to make new ones.

Driving Directions to New Dorp Moravian Church

While your GPS may direct you through a variety of side streets, we have found this to be simpler:

1. From the East (Brooklyn) using the Verrazano Bridge)

After crossing the bridge, continue West on Hwy 278. Exit at Exit 12 (Todt Hill Road and Slosson Road). At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Slosson (Note: Slosson will become Todt Hill Road.)

Continue on Todt Hill Road for about 2 miles. The gate to the Moravian Church will be on your right shortly after you pass the Richmond County Country Club Golf Course. From the West (Newark) and using the Goethals Bridge

If you are using the I95, the Goethel's Bridge is Exit 13. After crossing the bridge, continue East on Hwy 278 until Exit 12 (Todt Hill Road and Slosson Road). At the stop sign at the end of the ramp, turn RIGHT onto Todt Hill Road. Continue on Todt Hill Road for about 2 miles.

The gate to the Moravian Church will be on your right shortly after you pass the Richmond County Country Club Golf Course...

2. From the South (Perth Amboy) using the Outer bridge Crossing

After crossing the bridge, take Hwy 440 North (West Shore Expressway). Take Hwy 440 North until it connects with Hwy 278. Follow the signs directing you to the Verrazano Bridge (East). Once on Hwy 278, continue on until Exit 12. Turn RIGHT onto Todt Hill Road. Continue on Todt Hill Road until you come to the gate to the Moravian Church.

3. From South Staten Island (Tottenville)

From Tottenville, you can drive North (toward St. George) taking either Hylan Boulevard or Amboy Road for 7 - 8 miles. Using Amboy Road (which becomes Richmond Road at New Dorp Lane) you would just continue on Amboy Road until reaching Todt Hill Road, (the 3rd traffic light after New Dorp Lane).

Turn LEFT up the hill and then again turn LEFT through the gate to the Moravian Church. Using Hylan Boulevard, we recommend that you continue on Hylan until Lincoln Avenue (White Castle on the left.)

Turn LEFT onto Lincoln Avenue until Richmond Road. Turn LEFT onto Richmond Road. Go two blocks and turn RIGHT onto Todt Hill Road, and then LEFT through the gate.

Public Transportation to New Dorp Moravian Church

1. Bus:

The church is located on the route of the S74, S76 and The bus stop is at the corner of Richmond Road and Todt Hill Road, and it is a very short walk up the hill to the church.

2. Train/Staten Island Railway:

Exit the train at Grant City stop. Walk up Greeley Avenue two blocks to Richmond Road. The church is just up the hill on Todt Hill Road, and on your left.


Golf Shirts
