Description of class

Two quick projects to make in a one day class.

Morning - we'll make the wristlet! (pattern is "Kaitlynn's Just Right Bag" by Sue Pritt)

A wristlet large enough for your i-phone, ID, money, checkbook, glasses, etc

Afternoon is the Organizer Bag (pattern is "Gotta Have It Bag" by Sue Pritt)

Great bag for all your sewing supplies to take on retreats, sew-ins or just hang it next to your work station.

Skill Level

Beginners to advanced.

Number of Students

8 to 10

Supply List for Wristlet

Two coordinating fat quarters

Two 9" nylon zippers or longer

12" x 9" low loft batting

36" x 18" light fusible interfacing

Sewing machine with walking foot and usual sewing supplies

Supply List for Organizer Bag

1/3 yard OR 2 fat quarters

10" x 18" lining fabric (will NOT show once bag is made)

Four nylon zippers, 14" or longer

Thread to match all 4 zippers

Thread to match bag fabric

10" x 18" clear vinyl

10" x 18" low loft batting

10" x 18" fusible interfacing

Sewing machine with walking foot and usual sewing supplies

"Jump Start" directions

For Wristlet – follow cutting directions on inside front cover – don't forget to label all the parts! Place everything in a large ziptop baggie!

For Organizer Bag – Follow cutting directions at top of page ONE. ALSO, to save time in class, you can Quilt the outside bag (this usually takes longer then making the actual bag!) Follow step 7 on page TWO. Place everything in a large ziptop baggie!
