GRANT FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR ARTISTS TO PRODUCE ENVIRONMENTAL ART PROJECTS IN PERRY COUNTY

GREEN PARK—Stone House Farm & Inn of Hempfield Behavioral Health, in partnership with Perry County Council of the Arts, has grant funding available to fund eight Environmental Art Projects at the farm in Green Park, offering \$500 per project from December 2022 – July 2023.

All projects must be an environmental art project relating to the geographic area with high levels of community participation. Varying art types will be considered including but not limited to dance, photography, instrumental, plein air painting, natural fabric dyeing, pottery, and sculpture. The final art project must be a permanent product at the farm whether physical or a photographed/recorded project. Professional and student artists are welcome!

“The Art for All Program aims to engage a diverse group of participants from Perry County in a hands-on experience with environmental art at the farm.” said Deborah Shaffer of Hempfield Behavioral Health. “It has been designed to create a collaborative environment for all, in which each person’s artistic abilities and perspectives are valued and encouraged.”
