



## Restore, Revive, Refresh, Renew

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the

thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless you and your house and keep you; the Lord make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace; the Lord put His name on you and your house, and bless you (Num. 6:24-27). Grace be with you. (Col. 4:18) Glory to God the Father! (Luke 2:14) We don't come to the Father based on our own worthiness or on the worthiness of you and your family, but by Jesus Christ, whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose. (John 1:27) Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come before God's mercy seat on the merits of His Son, Jesus Christ, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19), for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev 5:12)! In the name of (John 16:23), Jesus the Christ, who heals you (Acts 9:34), as a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Hear our voice according to Your loving-kindness; O Lord, revive us according to Your justice. (Ps. 119:149-150) In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Son of the Most High, may the God of peace who brought up our Lord

Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you and your house complete in every good work to do His will, working in you and your family what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever (Heb. 13:20-21). May God, who is ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, abundant in kindness (Neh. 9:17), restore your soul and lead you and your people in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake (Ps. 23:3). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray our God and Father will prepare a table before you and your people in the presence of your enemies; may He anoint your head with oil; may your cup run over. Surely, goodness and mercy shall follow you and yours all the days of your life; and you will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. (Ps. 23:5-6). Let your flesh be young like a child's, may you and yours return to the days of youth. May you and your family pray to God, and He will delight in you and your house; you and your people shall see His face with joy, for He restores to you His righteousness. (Job 33:25-16) Yes, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that Jehovah-Mekoddishkem, the Lord Who Sanctifies You, will restore to you and your family the joy of His salvation, and uphold you and yours with His generous Spirit. (Ps. 51:12) According to His abundant mercy (1 Pet 1:3) may the Lord our God turn you and your family back to Him, and you will be restored and He will renew your days of old (Lam. 5:21). In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and confidence shall be your strength. (Is. 30:15) Praise the lord according to his righteousness. Sing praises to the name of the Lord Most High. (Ps. 7:17).

In the name of Jesus, through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), may the Lord our God bestow mercy on your household and refresh you often (2 Tim. 1:16), for Jehovah God did not forsake you and your house in your bondage, but He

extended mercy to you and your people, to revive you, to repair, restore (2 Chr. 34:10) and reinforce (2 Chr. 24:13) your house, a building from God, a house not made with hands, but eternal in the heavens (2 Cor. 5:1), to rebuild its ruins and to give you and yours a wall in Jerusalem (Ezra 9:9), the New Jerusalem (Rev. 3:12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God Almighty will restore to you and your family the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the consuming locust, and the chewing locust. May the Lord revive His work in you and your house in the midst of the years! In the midst of years may He make it known and remember mercy (Hab. 3:2), and restore double to you and your family (Zech. 9:12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we implore the God Most High to restore to your house all the land (2 Sam. 9:7) that was given to you as an inheritance (Gen. 13:17). For the LORD YOUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (Jer. 23:6) shall bring you and your people in and plant you in the mountain of His inheritance, in the place which He has made for His own dwelling, the sanctuary which His hands have established (Ex. 15:17). May He restore to you and your house all that was yours, and all the proceeds of the field from the day that you left the land until now (2 Kin. 8:6). May it please the Lord to restore your losses and give you twice as much as before (Job 42:10). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we make request for you and your house that God the Judge of all (Heb. 12:23) restore every man's money (Gen. 42:25), all the wealth of your house (Job 20:10), and may all your possessions be returned to your house in the year of Jubilee (Lev. 25:28). That which has been stolen from you and your house, let the thief restore sevenfold, even though he may have to give up all the substance of his house. (Prov. 6:31) Let you and your family delight yourselves also in the Lord and He shall give you the desires of your heart (Ps. 37:4), and our Father in heaven will grant to you and yours according to your heart's desire, and fulfill all of your purpose (Ps. 20:4). He shall increase your

greatness and comfort you and your house on every side (Ps. 71:21). May you and yours wait on the Lord and He shall renew your strength; you and your people shall mount up with wings like eagles, you shall run and not weary, you shall walk and not faint. (Is. 40:31) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 12:20) that you and your people will be rested (Ex. 31:17), refreshed and well (1 Sam. 16:23); that the Lord God will refresh your hearts (Gen. 18:5), your spirits (1 Cor. 16:18), and your souls (Prov.25:13). You and your people shall eat plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, who has dealt wondrously with His people, whom you are, and you and your house shall never be put to shame (Joel 2:25-26), instead excellent majesty will be added to you (Dan. 4:36). Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. (2 Pet. 1:2) The Lord is righteous in all His ways, gracious in all His works. The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth. (Ps. 145:17-18) The Lord preserves all who love Him. Let your mouth speak the praise of the Lord, and bless His holy name forever and ever. (Ps. 134:20-21)

In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of Jesus, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), that God will restore the excellence of your house (Nah. 2:2). The thief does not come except to steal, and kill, and destroy, Jesus comes to your house that you may have life, and that you may have it more abundantly (John 10:10). When the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which you have done, but according to His mercy He saved you, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on you and your house abundantly through Jesus Christ your Savior, that having been justified by His grace, you and your people should become heirs according to

the hope of eternal life. (Titus 3:4-7) The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works. All His works shall praise Him, and His saints shall bless Him. We shall speak of the glory of His kingdom, and talk of His power, to make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion endures throughout all generations. (Ps. 145:9-13)

in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we entreat the favor of the Lord our God, in the name of his only begotten son, Jesus Christ (1 John 4:9), and pray for you and your house (1 Kin. 13:6) that where sickness and disease has struck, that your flesh shall be restored to you, and you shall be clean (2 Kin. 5:10); that God will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds (Jer. 30:127); that you be revived and stand on your feet (2 Kin. 13:21). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will return to the Lord, and where He has torn, He will heal you and your people, and where He has stricken, He will bind you and your people up (Hos. 6:1). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family shall neither hunger nor thirst, neither heat or sun shall strike you (Is. 49:10) by day, nor the moon by night (Ps. 121:6), for He who has mercy on you, will lead you, even by the springs of water he will guide you (Is. 49:10). Let us meditate on the glorious splendor of His majesty, and on His wondrous works. We shall speak of the might of His awesome acts, and we will declare His greatness. We shall utter the memory of His great goodness, and shall sing of His righteousness. (Ps. 145:5-7)

El Roi, the God who sees, has seen your ways (Is. 57:18), and in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the precious name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), that where you and your house have been backsliding in the way of your heart (Is. 57:17), Jehovah will heal you (Is. 57:18), for the God of justice (Is. 30:18) will teach transgressors His ways, for His ways are everlasting (Hab. 3:6), and

sinners shall be converted to Him (Ps. 51:13). Where God has chastised you and your house, like an untrained bull, and although you may be ashamed and humiliated, because you bear the reproach of your youth, may God restore you and your house to the Lord your God, that you may turn, repent, receive instruction (Jer. 31:18-19) and be comforted in His comfort (2 Cor. 7:13), for the Lord **Jesus**, your Redeemer (Gal 4:5), is a restorer of life and a nourisher of your old age (Ruth 4:15). May the God of life (Ps. 42:8) show you and your house His ways, teach you and your people His paths. Lead you and yours in His truth and teach you, for He is the God of your salvation (Ps. 25:4). He will also lead you and your people, and restore comforts to you. Keep silence before God, O coast lands, and let you and your people renew your strength! Let you and your people come near to God, then let you speak; let you come near together for judgment (Is. 41:1). "I create the fruit of the lips: peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near" says the Lord "And I will heal him." (Is. 57:18-19). Sing O heavens! Be joyful, O earth! And break out in singing, O mountains! For the Lord has comforted His people, and will have mercy on His afflicted (Is. 49:13). May your lips greatly rejoice when you sing to the Lord, and your soul, which He has redeemed. Let your tongues also talk of His righteousness all the day long (Ps. 71:23-24), your meditation be sweet to Him (Ps. 104:34); and let you and your house be glad in the Lord (Ps. 104:34). For they are confounded, for they are brought to shame who seek your hurt (Ps. 71:23-24). May it please the God of your Salvation, the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy (Is. 57:15) to command the blessing upon you and your house. Behold, He has blessed, and no one can reverse it. (Num. 23:20) For there is no sorcery against your house, nor any divination against your people. (Num. 24:23) For Yours, Father in heaven, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever (Math 6:13)

In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the covenant of the people (Is. 42:6), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that the Lord God of Hosts to restore you and your house; that He will revive you and your people and cause His face to shine upon your house (Ps. 80:18-19). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Father of Righteousness (Prov. 23:24) will revive (Ps. 119:25) and strengthen you and your family according to His word (Ps. 119:28). That the God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) will revive you and your people in His way (Ps. 119:37) and in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40), according to His loving kindness, so that you and your house may keep the testimony of His mouth. Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven. Your faithfulness endures to all generations (Ps. 119:88-90). In your affliction may the Lord who heals (Ex. 15:26) revive you and your house according to His justice (Ps. 119:149), and teach you His judgments (Ps. 119:107). Let you and your people commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday. (Ps. 37:6) Though you and your family walk in the midst of trouble, He will revive you; He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of your enemies, and His right hand will save you and your house. The Lord will perfect that which concerns you and yours. His Mercy endures forever and He will not forsake the works of His hands. (Ps. 138:7-8) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray God will cause you and yours to hear His loving kindness in the morning; and cause you to know the way which you and your people should walk. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we implore you and yours to lift up your soul to Elohim (Gen 1:1), God our creator (Ecc. 12:1), and He will teach you to do His will and lead you in uprightness, revive you and your people for His righteousness' sake and bring your souls out of trouble (Ps. 143:8-11). The Lord upholds all who fall, and raises up all those who are bowed down. The eyes of all look expectantly to Him, and He gives them their food in due



season. He will open His hand and satisfy the desire of (Ps. 145:14-16) your heart (Ps. 37:4). Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ** your Savior (Titus 1:4).

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), let God's mercies come also to you and your house, His salvation according to His word (Ps. 119:41). May the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17) send chariots of salvation (Hab. 3:8), the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), and walk in the midst of your camp (Deut. 23:14). May El Elyon, the Most High God (Ps. 78:35), give to you and your house a banner, that it may be displayed because of the truth. That His beloved, you and your house, may be delivered, that he will save you and your house with His right hand and hear you (Ps. 60:5) and answer you. You shall cry and He will say "Here I am" (Is. 58:9). May the Lord of Hosts stir up His strength, and come and save you and your house! Restore you and your people to God; cause His face to shine upon you and your family (Ps. 80:17). In His mercy may the God of glory thunders (Ps. 29:3) cut off your enemies and destroy all those who afflict your soul (Ps. 143:12). May God your Father create in you a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within you and your people. Let Him never cast you or yours away from His presence nor take His Holy Spirit from you and your house. (Ps. 51:10-11) May the Lord, your strength and your redeemer (Ps. 19:14), revive you and your house and raise you up, that you may live in His sight. Let you and your people know and pursue the knowledge of the Lord. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to you and your house like the rain, like the latter and the former rain to the earth (Hos. 6:2-3). For the Lord your God will heal your backsliding; He will love you and your house freely (Hos. 14:4), He will restore you and your family in a spirit of gentleness. (Gal. 6:1) He will be like the dew to your house; you shall grow like the lily, and lengthen your roots like Lebanon. (Hos. 14:5) Your root shall

spread out to the waters, and the dew shall lie all night on your branch. (Job 29:19) Your branches shall spread; your beauty shall be like an olive tree, and your fragrance like Lebanon. Your scent shall be like the wine of Lebanon. Your fruit is found in God, you being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of the Most High God. (Phil. 1:9-11) May you and your house understand these things. May you know them. For the ways of the Lord are right; the righteous walk in them, but transgressors stumble in them. (Hos. 14:5-9) The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. (2 Cor. 13:14) May it please God that in your house, this generation shall praise His works to another, and shall declare His mighty acts. (Ps. 145:4) The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy. (Ps. 145:8) He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear your cry and save you and your house. (Ps. 145:4)

Great is God's tender mercies. In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), may the Lord revive you and your house according to His judgments (Ps. 119:156). Hear our voice according to Your loving kindness, O Lord (Ps. 119:149) for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10). May the God of compassion let not you and your people be robbed and plundered, snared in holes or hidden in prison houses. (Is. 49:6) Because of the blood of your covenant, by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Peter 1:19), God Almighty will set you and your house free from the waterless pit; may you and your people return to the stronghold of your God, and become prisoners of hope (Zech. 9:11-12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will extend your soul to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted soul, then your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday. The Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your

soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. Those from among you shall build the old waste places; you shall raise up the foundations of many generations; and you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, the Restorer of Streets to Dwell In (Is. 58:10-12). Out of your house shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of those who make merry; for the Lord your God will multiply you, and you shall not diminish; He will also glorify you, and you shall not be small. (Jer. 30:19) Let us extol Him, our God, our King; and we will bless His name forever and ever. Every day we will bless Him, and we will praise His name forever and ever. Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable. (Ps. 145:1-3)

The Lord is well pleased for His righteousness' sake, He will magnify the law in your hearts (Prov. 7:3), and make you honorable (Is. 42:21). In your house, may the father make known His truth to the children. (Is. 38:19) In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), the author and finisher of your faith (Heb 12:2), may father and child alike, repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord (Acts 3:19). Let you and your people restore what you have stolen, or the things which you have extorted, or what was delivered to you for safekeeping, or the lost thing which you found, or all that about which you have sworn falsely. Let you and your people restore its full value, add one-fifth more to it and give it to whomever it belongs. (Lev. 6:4-5) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (Rom. 12:2) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and yours put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according

to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind (Eph. 4:22-23), that your inward man be renewed day by day (2 Cor. 4:16), precept upon precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little (Is. 28:10); and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in righteousness and true holiness (Eph. 4:24). The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge. (Ps. 19:1-2) The Lord shall reign forever – Our God, to all generations. (Ps. 146:10)

We ask, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), your savior and your redeemer, that God your Father will restore to your people a pure language, that you all may call on the name of the Lord to serve Him with one accord (Zeph. 3:9). Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom. 15:5) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment (1 Cor. 1:10), being like-minded having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind (Phil. 2:2). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that Jesus will put his hand on your eyes and make you look up to your Father and Creator, to see the things which are not seen, to see the things that are eternal (2 Cor. 4:18), and that you and your people be restored that you see everyone clearly. May the God of compassion (Deut. 32:36) restore you and your house again (Ps. 60:1), and keep you from drinking the wine of confusion (Ps. 60:3). May the Lord send forth His Spirit and create (Ps. 104:30) in you and your people a new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created you (Col. 3:10). God Almighty shall renew the face of the earth. The glory of the Lord endures forever; the Lord

shall rejoice in His works - you and your people. (Ps. 104:30-31) May you and your family bless the Lord, with all your soul; and all that is within you, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, with all your soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Ps. 103:1-6). May Jehovah-Nisi, the Lord Our Banner, plead your cause and redeem you and your house; revive you and your people according to His word (Ps. 119:154). When you and yours are oppressed, may the Lord undertake for you (Is. 38:14). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Lord, who is good and ready to forgive and abundant in mercy (Ps. 84:5), to restore your spirit from the bitterness of your soul (Is. 38:15), and make you live (Is. 38:6) and abundant life (John 10:10) rich in the fruits of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22). For we know that our Redeemer lives! (Job 19:24) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will purify your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), in sincere love of the brethren, loving one another fervently with a pure heart, having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that Jesus Christ will dwell in your heart through faith (Eph. 3:17), and having been crucified with Christ it will no longer be you who lives, but Christ living in you; and the life which you now live in the flesh you shall live by faith in the Son of God, who loved you and gave Himself for you (Gal. 2:20). For though Christ was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For you also are weak in Him, but you shall live with him by the power of God toward you. May you and your people examine yourselves as to whether you are in the

faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves that Jesus Christ is in you? Let us join with every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them saying: "Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever." (Rev 5:13)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17, 19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time

has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14), for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), we ask our Father in heaven, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). For it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8) The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12), and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it (Is. 55:11). For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. (Is. 57:15) At that time Jerusalem shall be called The Throne of the Lord, and all your family shall be

gathered to it, to the name of the Lord, to Jerusalem; you shall walk no more after the stubbornness of your evil heart. (Jer. 3:17) For then God, will restore to your people a pure language that you all may call on the name of the Lord, to serve Him with one accord. (Zeph. 3:9) In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it. You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
