Personal Responsibility and Meaningful Worship

Every worshiper desires public worship that is vibrant, meaningful, and inspirational. Unfortunately most worshipers seem to hold worship leaders fully responsible for accomplishing that. While church leaders can and should bear significant responsibility for making periods of public worship vibrant and meaningful, they shouldn't bear full responsibility for doing so. There are several things that only an individual worshiper can do to ensure that public worship is an enriching, meaningful, and inspirational experience. Let me suggest three.

- 1. **Spend time in private worship.** If a person's private worship life is virtually non-existent, it will be virtually impossible to find meaning and inspiration in public worship. On the other hand, those who spend time regularly communing with God through private prayers, Scripture reading, and hymns of praise are much more likely to find meaning and inspiration when they gather with God's people to worship.
- 2. **Prepare physically and mentally prior to worship.** Speaking from personal experience, it is difficult to find enrichment in public worship if a person is physically exhausted or has not taken the time to meditate on God and spiritual matters prior to a public service. If a person goes to bed late on Saturday night, wakes up late on Sunday morning, frantically rushes to get everyone in the house dressed and fed, speeds into the church parking lot one minute past time to begin, runs into the building carrying a child under each arm, and collapses into a pew tense, haggard and exhausted, that person should almost "expect" to find the service minimally enriching. Most people will find public worship much more meaningful and inspirational if they will get plenty of sleep on Saturday, rise early on Sunday, spend a few minutes in reflective reading from the Psalms or some other portion of Scripture, spend a few minutes in prayer, wake the family in time to dress, eat, and drive to the building at a casual pace, and arrive at the building several minutes prior to the scheduled start of a service.
- 3. **Keep in mind the primary purpose of worship.** Worshipers are more likely to find meaning, inspiration, and enrichment in public worship if they keep in mind that they are there primarily to give honor and praise to God, not get some sort of personal reward. God has designed worship in such a way that its fullest blessings are bestowed on those who worship primarily in order to give rather than to get. Those who go to worship primarily seeking emotional gratification through entertainment, or some other personal payoff, will often find the service uninspiring or less than meaningful regardless of how effective each element or activity is carried out.
