

- CLASS 1 **RAZMATAZ PERPETUAL FOX HUNT CLASS**
 Donated by Mary Wolcott. Simulates hunt. Horses will follow field master around course with short check. Course will be set by master. 1st flight jumping, 2nd flight follows group, no jumping, ribbons to both fields.
- CLASS 2 **ANN BLYTHE DAVIS MEMORIAL TROPHY**
 Open equitation on the flat for riders 13 years and under. Walk, trot and canter in ring.
- CLASS 3 **SHADE TREE RANCH EQUITATION CHALLENGE TROPHY 14-17**
 Donated by Holly Shade. Walk, trot and canter in ring. Permanent possession must be won twice in succession by same horse and rider.
- CLASS 4 **GREEN WORKING HUNTERS UNDER SADDLE**
 Walk, trot and canter in ring. Horse's way of going.
- CLASS 5 **JUNIOR HUNTERS UNDER SADDLE (UNDER 18)**
 Walk, trot, and canter. Horse's way of going.
- THE HUNTSMAN'S PERPETUAL TROPHY FOR ADULT WORKING HUNTERS UNDER SADDLE (18 and older)**
 Donated by Susan Roth and Susan Mefford. Walk, trot, and canter. Horses way of going. Trophy retained by WHC.
- EQUISEUSE WORKING HUNTERS UNDER SADDLE (ALL AGES)**
 Donated by Sandy Azzopardi. Walk, trot, canter and hand gallop in ring. Trophy retained by WHC.
- 18" TROT CLASS**
 Class for green horses, ponies or riders. Class will be split if a large class. Short course with distances between fences. No water or banks, fences 18" or under. Horses should trot.
- 18" CANTER CLASS**
 As above. Inviting fences 18" and under. Horses should canter.
- CLASS 10 **24" TROT COURSE**
 As above. Inviting fences 2' or less. Horses should trot.
- CLASS 11 **THE LANDELLA TROPHY**
 All fences 2' or under. Horses should canter. Trophy donated by Holly Bordeaux. Permanent possession must be won 3 times by same horse and rider.
- CLASS 12 **ROYAL GEM EQUITATION CHALLENGE TROPHY**
 Junior equitation 17 years and under. Over fences. To be won 3 times for permanent possession.
- CLASS 13 **THE BONFIRE PERPETUAL TROPHY FOR JUNIOR WORKING HUNTERS** Donated by Mr & Mrs John C. Hunter.
- CLASS 14 **THE FOX BRUSH FARM CHALLENGE TROPHY FOR WORKING HUNTERS**
 Slightly more difficult course, may include banks, water, fences 2'6" or under. Donated by Mary Davidson. Permanent possession must be won 3 times by same horse and rider.
- CLASS 15 **GRETCHEN BUESCHING MEMORIAL TROPHY**
 Handy hunter course. Trappy course, sharper turns, banks, water. Perpetual trophy.
- CLASS 16 **DESIGN YOUR OWN COURSE UNDER 24" FENCES**
 Jump 8 of the 10 designated fences on course in any direction or order. Judged on flow and creativity.
- CLASS 17 **DESIGN YOUR OWN COURSE 24-36' FENCES**
 As above, but larger fences for the more experienced horses and riders.
- CLASS 18 **ALFRED GLANCY JR. MEMORIAL TROPHY**
 Family class. At least 1 member must jump at least 3 fences. Walk, trot and canter. Trophy retained by WHC.
- CLASS 19 **EXCALIBUR CHALLENGE TROPHY FOR QUALIFIED WORKING HUNTERS**
 Open to horses and riders who have hunted one season. Trophy donated by Excalibur Horse Center. Permanent possession must be won 3 times by same horse and rider.
- CLASS 20 **WINDY RIDGE FARM TROPHY FOR OPEN WORKING HUNTERS**
 Donated by Fred Boudeman. Trophy retained by WHC, typical hunter course.
- CLASS 21 **W. NELSON VANDER HYDEN TROPHY FOR PAIRS OF HUNTERS**
 Horses ride and jump side by side, similarity of pairs considered. May find partner on show grounds. Time available for schooling.
