There are roofs, we replaced or repaired $6\frac{1}{2}$ in the last 18 months, and have at least $4\frac{1}{2}$ to go not including some leaks in our church and main residential building. We have a lot of electrical work to do. For one thing, our water well just went out. Praise to the Lord, we bought a \$500 electrical part in El Paso and the Water Company of Juarez installed it for us. It is working again! This time the damage was not 150 meters below the ground where the pump is, like before. We also need a lot of painting, carpentry, fencing, etc., everywhere. Our 15,000 sq. ft. residential building is settling too much, causing small cracks in the walls and first floor. We are seeing if by putting extra reinforced concrete under the existing foundation imbedded into the caliche below the foundation in two places on one side of the stairwell, will work. If it does, we may need 28 of them all around the building.

Only two groups came to help in the last year. We used to have many, some of them with up to 100 people. They helped in many ways including showing Jesus' love to the children. Some of their organizations also used to support us financially. So, we have to raise the money for all the materials and supplies. We do a lot of the labor, but have to pay for some also.

The repute and violence in Juarez is are still keeping them away, even though we are in a very safe place and can provide armed guards from the border to us and back.
