Recipe Book

Pflaumen Kuchen

Ingredients: 1 cup sugar 1/2 cup butter 1 tsp. baking powder 2 eggs 2 prune plums pinch of salt Cinnamon and sugar for



Cinnamon and sugar for topping 1 tbsp. lemon juice

Preheat oven to 350F. Semi-melt butter and add in sugar. Add flour, baking powder, salt, and eggs. Beat well. Spray 8in. pie pan with oil/butter thoroughly. Spoon batter into pan. Place plum slices on top in design of your choice. Sprinkle with cinnamon/sugar mixture and lemon juice.

Bake for 1 hour. Cool on rack until lukewarm. Serve with whipped cream or ice cream. These also freeze well. Makes 8 servings.
