

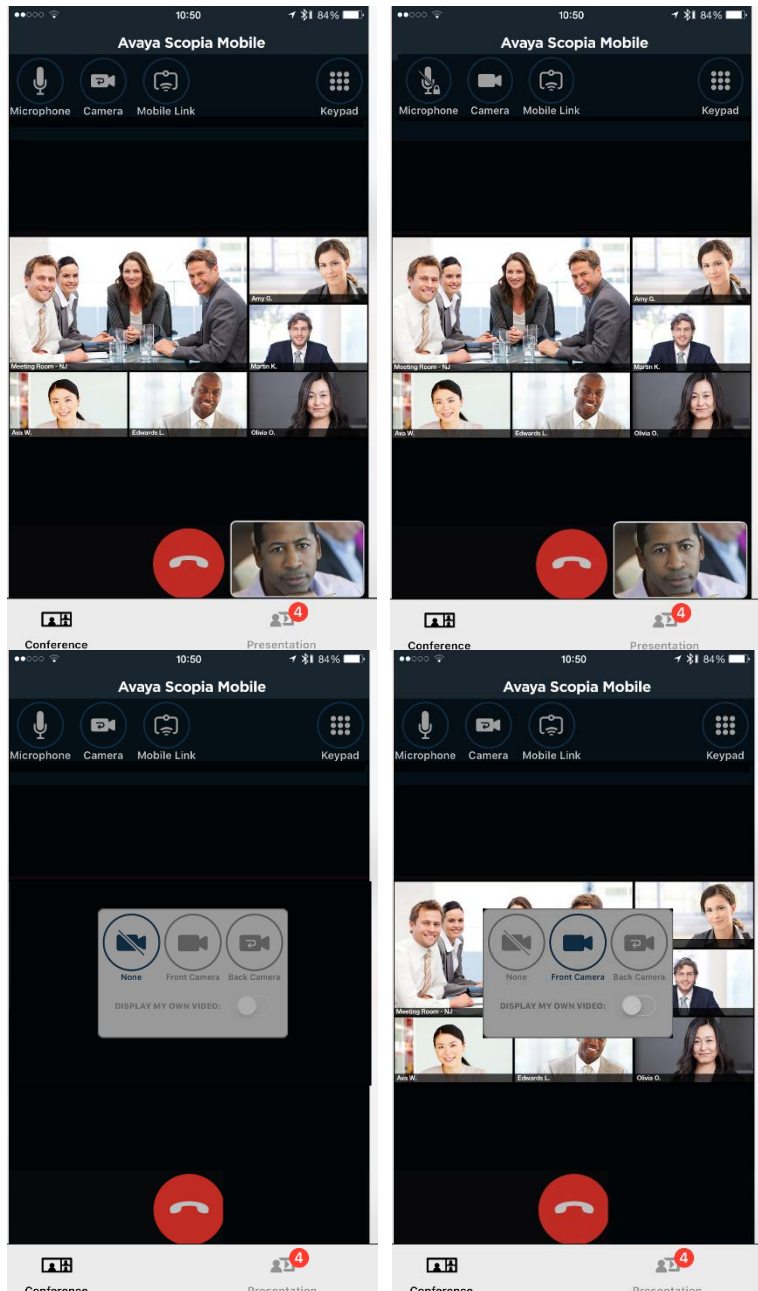


## 3CMeNow SCOPIA User Interface – for iPhone, iPad and iTouch iOS Platform

### Mute, Camera, Keypad and Disconnect SCOPIA MOBILE v3

The purpose of the steps outlined below is to show you how to operate the SCOPIA Mobile v3 User Interface including your device's microphone and camera.

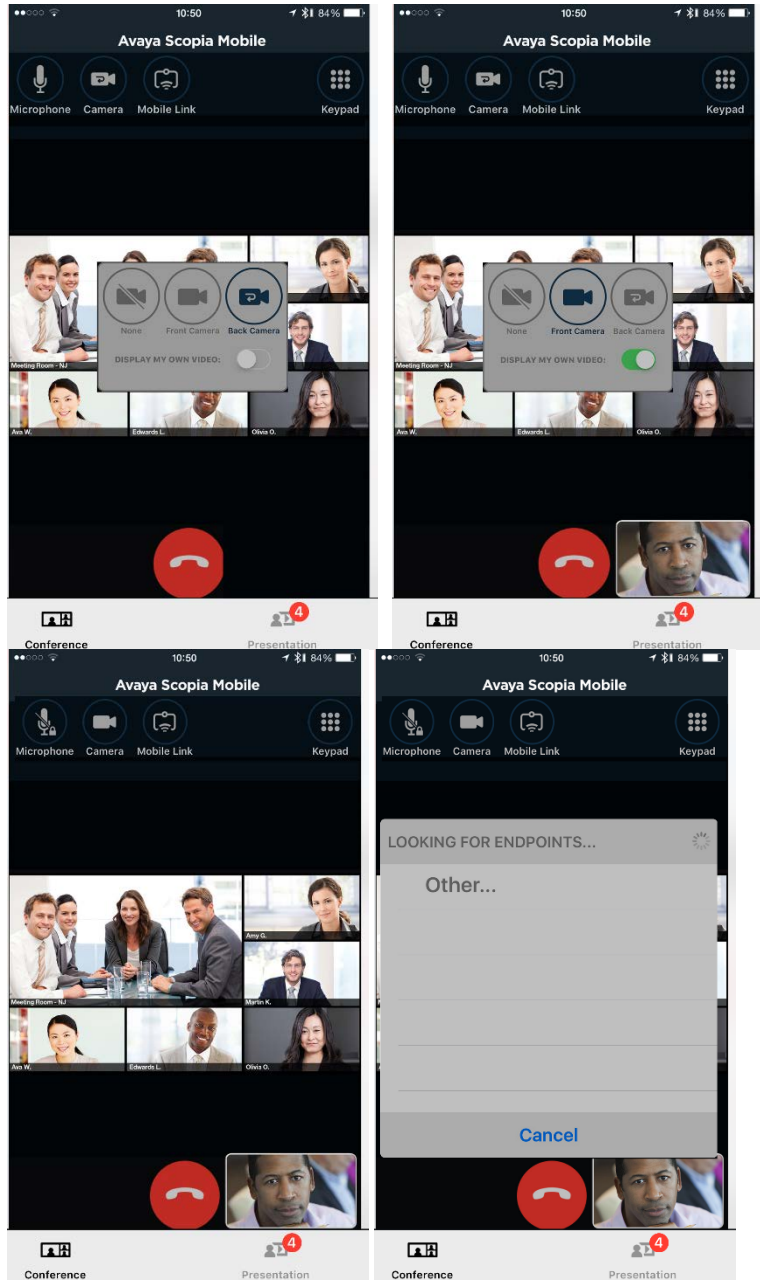
1. Press anywhere from below the Scopia 969.... Meeting ID on the top left and the video
2. Press the **Mute** button to mute your microphone.
  - The **Mute** button is white when the microphone is unmuted.
  - The **Mute** button has a forward slash through when the microphone is muted.
3. Press the **Camera** button to control the camera functions. Press the one of the three 3 Options to activate it:
  - a. **No Camera**- no video from your device is shown to other participants
  - b. **Front Camera** – shows the video from your front camera to other participants

- c. **Back Camera** – shows the video from your Back camera to other participants.
- d. **Display my own video** (located in the lower right corner of the screen) – allows you to see the video you are sending to other participants. You may turn this function off so the other participant's video will be larger. You may also move this video around by touching and dragging the video.
4. **Mobile Link** button--Currently Mobile Link only works with SCOPIA XT Series Endpoints.



5. Press the red  **Disconnect** button on the bottom to exit the meeting.
6. Press **Yes** when asked **Are you sure you want to disconnect?**
  - Note: there are no moderator privileges from mobile devices so you cannot **terminate** a meeting.
