This special evening will begin with a group dance lesson that will start promptly at 7:00 PM! Please arrive earlier than usual, allowing time to stop at the admission table before the lesson. Dancing will begin at 7:30 PM, and DJ Richard Richards will provide his elegant mix of music until 10 PM.

Attire: dressy casual.

Group Lesson: Tango. If you would like to expand your American Tango repertoire, please join Richard Richards and Rita Snyder for their group lesson at 7 PM. They will teach a practical pattern that involves elements from Argentine Tango.

Richard and Rita serve as the instructors for UA's Social Dance class, and they were the founding coaches for the UA Competition Ballroom Team. Though they enjoy social dancing and promoting social dance, they are themselves serious ballroom competitors: They will be competing at the highest, Championship, level in International Standard and Latin at USADance Nationals in April.

Exhibition. Richard and Rita have graciously accepted TBDC's invitation to offer an exhibition at our Springtime in Paris Dance! During first break, they will offer exhibitions of International Rumba *and* Paso Doble!

Line dancing is invited throughout the evening. Though the space between the tables and the DJ is reserved for ballroom dancers, the space between the tables and snacks is reserved for line dancers. This space can also accommodate couples who would like to practice dance patterns.

Directions. The entrance to McAbee Center's parking lot is at the intersection of Loop Road and Veterans Memorial Parkway. As one faces McAbee Center, the VA Hospital is located to the right of and behind McAbee Center. From Birmingham, take interstate Exit 79 for University Blvd. At the end of the exit ramp, bear right onto University Blvd. After 4.6 miles, turn left at the traffic light onto Veterans Memorial Pkwy. In ½ mile, turn left onto Loop Rd and then take an immediate left turn to access McAbee Center's parking lot.
