DESCRIPTION: Rare Mercury all-purpose bow. Very little is known about the Mercury bow brand. It is thought that Mercury was a FASCO bow line, as the FASCO Model 35 and Mercury Model 350 were both rare 63" bows and have a similar (if not identical) design. Drake and FASCO archery companies were purchased by Seattle Archery in the mid-1960's, and their catalog featured Drake, FASCO, and Mercury bows, along with a couple of other lines.

This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Green limbs; Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed). Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
