CREEK WILDFIRE VICTIMS

In California, before you may sue a public entity (a state, county or local governmental entity) for money damages, you must first file a claim meeting the requirements of *California Government Code* Section 911.2(a). With very limited exceptions, no lawsuit for money damages may be brought against a governmental entity unless a written claim has been properly filed within the six-month time limit. If you've become a victim of the Creek Fire, it is important to preserve your rights! Please call Todd Becker (562) 708-1111 with any questions. Claim Deadline Approaching

June 5, 2018 marks the six month statutory date in preserving your right to file a lawsuit against a public entity. It has been reported that the Department of Water and Power, a county entity, is currently under investigation in relation to the cause of the Creek Fire.
