SHOWMANSHIP DIVISION BREAKDOWN

- **SENIOR** ~ 19 - 18 - 17 - 16 - 15 ~ First place winners in each age class are brought back for Senior Champion.
- **JUNIOR** ~ 14 - 13 - 12 - 11 ~ First place winners in each age class are brought back for Junior Champion.
- **BEGINNERS** ~ 10 - 9 - 8 - 7 ~ First place winners in each age class are brought back for Beginner Champion.
- **NEWBIE CLASS** ~ This class is for any youth ages 7 - 19 as of January 1, 2014 that wishes to participate in showmanship but may not have a goat of their own or may not be ready to show in the regular classes - youth participating in this class may borrow a goat to show.
- **PEE WEE CLASS** ~ This class is for youth 2-6 as of January 1, 2014 ~ youth participating in this class may borrow a goat to show.

MARKET GOAT CLASSES

All market goats must be disbudded or dehorned & must be slicked sheared from hoofs up including head & excluding pom on end of tail - non-bred does may show in this class providing they meet all other requirements - JLGA Market Does may also show in other JLGA Classes they are eligible for (Commercial Doe - Percentage Doe - Fullblood Doe) providing a separate entry fee is paid - JLGA Market Goats are no longer mouthed.

COMMERCIAL DOES

All Commercial Does must have COM tattooed in one ear & DOE in the other - they may show with or without horns - they do not have to be slick sheared - Doelings must have all milk teeth & will be weighed - Yearlings are up to 4 permanent teeth - Aged anything over 4 permanent teeth - All Commercial Does must be brought to the market scales to be mouthed & have tattoos checked.

AOB COMPANION WETHER CLASS

This class is for "Any other breed" than Boers or cross wethers - This is a companion wether class & thus these goats are not judged on meat yields, rather on confirmation & as companions - these wethers are not to be slick sheared - groomed according to breed specifics - dairy wethers may be body clipped or trimmed for a neater appearance - All entries in this class must be purebred or 100% of their breed & registered as a wether with their breed registry - Breeds shown in the class in the past have included Nubian & Nigerian Dwarfs Dairy Breeds, Myotonics, & Pygmies.

AOB BUCK & DOE CLASSES

These classes are for "Any other breed" than Boers, Pygmies, or Dairy, such as Myotonics, Savannahs, any hair breeds such as Angora, or any dual purpose goats such as Kinder goats - all goats in these classes must be purebred or 100% of their respective breeds & registered with their breed registries.

DAIRY BUCK & DOE CLASSES

Nigerian Dwarf Does - due to the increase in entries in the last couple of years on a trial basis for 2015 the Nigerian Dwarf Does will have their own class, complete with their own champions. Nigerian Dwarf Bucks will remain in the regular Dairy classes with the other dairy breed bucks. In the future if the Nigerian Buck numbers increase significantly, then those number will be re-evaluated for the following show season.

Dairy Buck & Doe Classes - on a trial basis for 2015, our Dairy Doe Classes will now consist of 2 divisions. Division 1 Dairy will be any ADGA recognized Dairy breeds including Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, & Sables. For the Dairy Buck classes Division 1 Nigerian Dwarf Buck are included in this division. Division 2 AOD (Any other Dairy) will consist of any registered Experimental, Grade, or any other non-ADGA recognized Dairy Breed(s) such as the mini dairy breeds. Each division will compete against themselves & Junior & Senior Champions will be chosen from each division, then both division's Jr. & Sr. Champions will come back to compete for Dairy Champions of the day.

Under each show listed it will be noted which JLGA "Dairy Hair Length Rule" applies.

FULLBLOOD BOER DOE CLASSES

These classes are for all purebred to 100% Boer s and does - all must be registered with their breed specific registry - may show with or without horns.

Boer Buck Classes

Boer Bucks - on a trial basis for 2015, our Fullblood Boer Buck Class will change to Boer Bucks & will consist of 2 divisions. Division 1 Boer Bucks will be registered Fullblood Boer Bucks. Division 2 will be registered Percentage Boer Bucks. Each division will compete against themselves & Junior & Senior Champions will be chosen from each division, then both division's Jr. & Sr. Champions will come back to compete for Boer Buck Champions of the day.

PERCENTAGE BOER DOE CLASS

The class is for all percentage boer does 50% up to purebred status - all entries in this class must be registered with their specific breed registry - they may show with or without horns.

PYGMY BUCK & DOE CLASSES

This class is for all pygmy goats purebred to 100% of their breed & must be registered with their breed specific registry - all pygmy goats are to be disbudded or dehorned.
