Q. When is open enrollment?

A. 4 courses a year are offered. The admissions office will have a current list of dates and times. Application packet is due 2 weeks prior to the start date.

Q. What is considered a complete packet?

A. A complete packet includes the all required documents: application, accuplacer (sentence skills only), immunization records, and one job reference letter.

Q. How long is the course?

A. CNA classes vary between 4 or 6 week classes. The four week classes are full days, M-Th from 8-4:30 p.m. The 6 week classes are half days, M-Th. Please check with admissions for starting dates and times.

Q. Is financial aid available?

A. No, unfortunately the course does not offer financial aid.

Q. How many people are accepted into the program?

A. The program accepts 12 students.

Q. When and where is the Accuplacer test given?

A. The test is administered in the Financial Aid Office. The cost of the Accuplacer Sentence Skills test is \$5 and no appointment is needed, but it is given on a first come first serve basis. You may test M-F from 730-11 a.m.

Q. How will I know if I am accepted into the program that I chose?
