**Science**--<u>Fifth grade & Sixth Grade</u>: scientific method: Comparing the different containers to see if glycerine keeps bubbles from popping; students applied Daniel Bernouli's Principle to keep bubbles flying through the air

**Geography**--United States: states & capitals; major cities of the U.S.; physical features of the U.S.

**Social Studies**--Exploration Unit: Bartholomew Diaz, Vasco da Gama, Christopher Columbus, Hernan Cortez, Francisco Pizzaro, Aztec and Inca people; the students researched on different explorers finding out what country they sailed, the years they explored, and what they explored or discovered.

**Physical Education**--softball unit: base running; hitting, fielding, and a game of wiffle ball
