

ISLAMIC WORDS & PHRASES	ENGLISH MEANING	WHEN & HOW TO USE
Bismillah	In the name of Allah.	Say at the start of anything, whatever a Muslim wants to start (driving, eating, walking, reading, entering the house)
Bismillah Ar Rahman Ar Raheem.	In the name of Allah, the most gracious the most merciful.	Say at the beginning of any Du'a or Supplication, at the start of reading the Holy Quran. Equivalent to "Bismillah"
Alhamdulillah.	Praise be to Allah	Say to express satisfaction or thanking Allah for a blessing. Say when sneezing
RahimakAllah.	May Allah have mercy on you, or May Allah bless you.	Say in response to hearing someone Say Alhamdulillah when sneezing
Yarhamuk-Allah	May Allah have mercy on you, or May Allah bless you.	Say in response to hearing someone Say Alhamdulillah when sneezing
Yahdikumu Allah wa Yuslihu balakum.	May Allah guide you and set your affairs right	In response to someone who said "RahimakAllah" or "Yarhamuka Allah" to you after you sneezed.
Subhanallah.	Glory to Allah or Allah is free from imperfections.	Say to express amazement at something.
Mashallah.	Allah has willed it	Say to express amazement or to show appreciation for a person or happening.
Allahu Akbar.	Allah is great (greater)	Say to accept sovereignty of Allah
La hawla wala quwata illa billah.	There is no change/transformation nor power/strength except through Allah	Say to express dissatisfaction in unfavorable situations beyond ones control.
Bismillah Awaluhu wa Akhiruhu.	In the name of Allah, at its beginning and at its end.	When someone forgets to say Bismillah before starting a meal and remembers in the middle of the meal.
Inshallah.	If Allah wills	Say when referring to or planning to do a future action, I will do this ... if Allah wills it.
Inna lillahi wa inna Ilaihi Rajioun.	To Allah we belong, and to him we will return.	Say when you hear someone died, or if you had a terrible lost (financial or personal).
Astaghfiru lillah.	I seek forgiveness from Allah.	Say when you do something wrong or you are sorry for your bad action
Salla Allahu alayhi wa sallam(SAW)	May Allah honor him and grant him peace (PBUH)	A way to praise the prophet (PBUH). Say aloud whenever you hear or write the Prophet Muhammad's Name or his reference.
Assalamu Alaikum.	Peace be upon you.	Say when meeting another Muslim
Wa alaykumu asalam	Peace be unto you to	In response to Assalamu Alaikum
Assalamu Alaikum warahmatu Allahi wa barakatuhu.	Peace be upon you and Allah's mercy and blessings.	This is a full equivalent of the above mentioned greeting "Assalamu Alaikum". Considered to be more polite and more rewarding to use it.
Wa alaykumu asalam warahmatu Allahi wa barakatuhu.	Peace be upon you and Allah's mercy and blessings be upon you to	This is a full equivalent of the above mentioned greeting "Assalamu Alaikum warahmatu Allahi wa barakatuhu.".
A'udhu billahi min ash shaytaan ir rajeem	I seek refuge in Allah from the cursed Satan "shaitan	Say when feeling unsafe or before entering unsafe places, or when scared by something for protection.
Jazaka Allahu Khairan	May Allah reward you with all good.	When someone does something good to you (gives you something, helps you with something ...)
