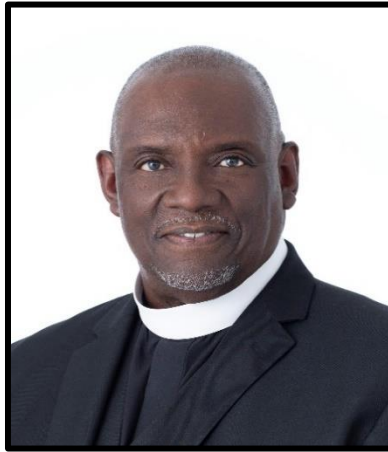

Presiding Elder Tan C. Moss



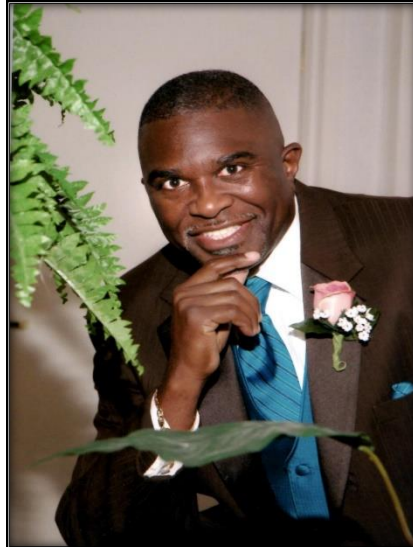
Reverend Tan C. Moss is the son of the late Rev. Nehemiah Bowers and the late Mrs. Luella S. Bowers, and the grandson of the late Rebenia Dawson. He was born and reared in Havana, Florida and educated in the Gadsden County Public School System, graduating from the historic Northside High School in 1974. Rev. Moss earned a B.S. degree in Political Science and a Masters degree in Applied Social Science from the Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and a Master of Divinity from the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Georgia. Employed by the state of Florida, Department of Labor and Employment Security for 24 years, he has an extensive background in organizational management and personnel supervision.

Reverend Moss accepted his call to ministry in 1999 while at Palace AME Church, under the pastoral leadership of the late Rev. Roosevelt Henderson. He was ordained an Itinerant Elder in the AME Church in 2004 and has had the wonderful privilege of serving the following churches in a pastoral capacity: Old Greenville AME, Ford Chapel AME, Mt. Pisgah AME, Springfield AME, Greater Payne AME, and the Greater Grant Memorial AME Church in Jacksonville, Florida. At the 2021 11th Episcopal District Planning Meeting, Bishop Frank Madison Reid III appointed Rev. Moss as Presiding Elder of the Miraculous Marianna District.

Reverend Moss previously served as the chair of the East Conference Board of Examiners, member of the East Conference Board of Trustees, the Ministerial Alliance, past co-president of the Jacksonville justice ministry ICARE, (Interfaith Coalition for Action Reconciliation and Empowerment), member of the Community Hospice Clinical Pastoral Education Professional Advisory Group. He also is a proud member of the Phi Beta Sigma fraternity, C.H. Henry Lodge #543, Free and Accepted Mason, PHA, and a life member of the Florida A&M University National Alumni Association.

The greatest joy in Reverend Moss' life aside from his relationship with Christ is the loving partnership he shares with his wife of 39 years, Mrs. Brenda H. Moss. God has blessed this relationship with five beautiful children and four grandchildren. It is through the love of God, the love of family and the love and care for God's people that Rev. Moss has found his true calling and is experiencing total fulfillment of God's purpose for his life.

Born and raised in the Waukeenah/Monticello Florida community, Jeff is the fourth of seven children. He was educated in the Jefferson County School System. From seventh through the twelfth grade, he was a member of the band and played the Tuba. After high school graduation, Jeff attended Tuskegee Institute (University), Tuskegee, Alabama, and was a member of the Marching Crimson Pipers Band. May 1984, he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business and Administration.

On February 9, 1989, Jeff accepted his Call to Preach the Gospel. After being ordained an Itinerant Deacon in the 1992 Florida Annual Conference, he began his pastoring in the Old West Florida Annual Conference, Marianna District. Jeff has pastored several churches in the Florida Annual Conference and is the current pastor of Bethel AME Church in Monticello, Florida.

Jeff is married to Carol; they have two children and seven grandchildren. He is a family man who is always concerned about family and fellowship. Most importantly, he loves the Lord and work every day to please God with a smile on his face.



Reverend Louisa L. Thomas

The Reverend Louisa Love Thomas is a native of Gadsden County. She was born in Havana (Concord), Florida. She completed grade school in Havana and High School in Winter Haven (Jewett High). She returned to Havana, attended Lively Vocational Technical School, earned a degree in Business Management, and began employment at Florida State University in 1966. Her employment at the Florida State University continued for 36 years, wherein she gained a wealth of knowledge, and furthered her education. In 2003, she retired from the Florida State University and became a full-time Pastor.

The Reverend Louisa L. Thomas began her Christian Walk in New St. John A.M.E. Church in Havana at age seven by singing in the youth choir. She was baptized at age 13. She is a visionary and a person of many talents.

Equipping herself for the journey, Reverend Thomas served on every Board and Auxiliary within the AME church. At her home church, she organized choirs; fostered Church Growth and Expansion; and developed a Church Outreach Ministry. In 1992, she answered her call to preach the gospel and received license to preach under the leadership of the late Reverend Willie E. Hagen. During this time, she served as the Mistress of Ceremony of the Havana Choir Union, was an Inspirational Speaker, a Community Activist, and the Chaplain of the National Council of Negro Women in Tallahassee.

Reverend Thomas attended the Florida Conference School of Religion of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. She was ordained Itinerant Deacon in 1996; ordained Itinerant Elder in 1998, and assigned to Ebenezer AME Church, Quincy. In 2000, she received her second pastoral appointment, which was to Steward Temple AME Church, Quincy, where she currently serves.

The Reverend Louisa L. Thomas has served in several leadership roles during her tenure. On the Annual Conference level, she was the first female to be elected an Alternate Delegate to the General Conference. She has served as President of the Florida Conference Women in Ministry; Assistant Statistician; Chief Conference Statistician and is the first female Chief Secretary of the Florida Annual Conference where she has served since 2013. On the Presiding Elder's District level, she has served as District Secretary; Administrative Assistant; and on the Board of Examiners. Since 1998, she has served under the leadership of five (5) different Presiding Elders.

During her tenure in Pastoral Leadership, she completed major renovations on both churches that she pastored. At Ebenezer, she replaced the roof, had carpet installed on virgin floors, improved the church lighting, added a Fellowship Hall and duct-work for future central heat and air. At Steward Temple, a complete transformation has taken place under her leadership. The church is now a state-of-the-art facility, and a beacon of hope for the Gadsden County Community. With a heated baptismal pool and electronic capabilities, the church is ready to serve the present age.

Reverend Louisa Love Thomas is married to Mr. John A. Thomas of Quincy, Florida. Together they have three children; three grandchildren; and one great-great grandson, all of whom they love and adore.

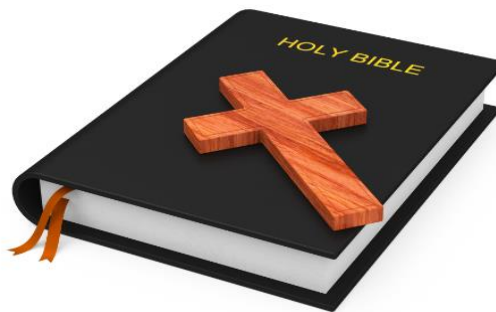

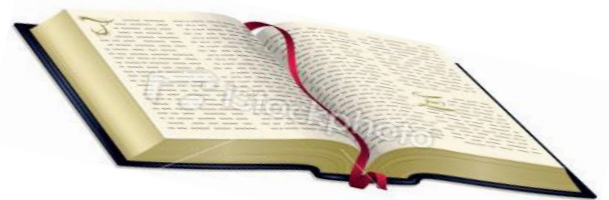
