No. 3 Oregon led by QB Dillon Gabriel upset No. 2 Ohio State 32-31 as 3-point home underdogs last Saturday night. It was the first match-up of Top 5 teams in the history of Autzen Stadium. The two teams could rematch in the Big Ten Championship game.

Misleading Finals

Northwestern (+10.5) upset Maryland 37-10. However, Maryland had 25-10 first down and 355-283 yard edges but were -4 in TO's.

Buffalo (+10.5) upset Toledo 30-15. However, Toledo had a 418-357 yard edge but were -2 in TO's and were stopped on downs at the Buffalo 11, 27 and 33-yard lines.

Minnesota (-3.5) beat UCLA 21-17. However, UCLA had a 329-234 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

Iowa (-3) blew out Washington 40-16. However, Washington had a 393-328 yard edge but were -2 in TO's and had a short FG blocked.

Pittsburgh (-3.5) beat California 17-15. However, Cal had a 335-277 yard edge but missed a FG and an extra-point.

BYU (-3) blew out Arizona 41-19. However, they only outgained Arizona by 11 yards as the Wildcats were -3 in TO's. BYU got a 9-yard TD drive, got a FG on zero yards of offense after a TO and also got a "Pick 6."

UL-Lafayette (-10.5) beat Appalachian State 34-24. However, App St had a 391-364 yard but had 5 TO's.

Western Michigan (-9.5) beat Akron 34-24. However, Akron had a 501-389 yard edge but were -4 in TO's.

Nevada (+3) upset Oregon State 42-37. However, Oregon State had a 562-422 yard edge but were -4 in TO's and were also stopped on downs at the Nevada 3.

Bad Beats

UNLV (-19) led Utah State 41-7 at halftime. However, Utah State got a back-door cover TD with 1:18 left to lose 50-34.

UTSA was a 3.5-point favorite at Rice and the total was 51. Rice led 23-13 midway through the 4Q. UTSA scored 2 TD's to take a 27-3 lead but Rice got a 18-yard TD pass with :04 left to win 29-27 to get the cover and put the game OVER.

Marshall (+1) led Georgia Southern 23-3 with 7 minutes left in the fourth quarter. GS got a questionable safety, then Marshall turned it over on each of their last 3 possessions with GS scoring 3 TD's the last coming via 34-yard pass with 1:00 left.

Wednesday, October 16th

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

SAM HOUSTON STATE 28 Western Kentucky 27. Winner has the inside track on the CUSA Championship game. Both teams have played similar schedules but Sam Houston has the better ypp margin (+0.3 vs -0.2) and is 5-1 ATS (+10.2 ppg). However, WKU has covered 5 straight games since the opening loss to Alabama. We bet WKU.
Fiu 26 UTEP 21. UTEP is one of 3 teams that remains winless on the season (Kent State and Kennesaw State are the others). UTEP has played the tougher schedule (No. 66 vs No. 113) but FIU has a much better ypp margin (0.0 vs -1.2). Early week money has been on FIU and the UNDER. We haven't bet it yet.

Thursday, October 17th

VIRGINIA TECH 28 Boston College 21. Both teams want a win for ACC bowl positioning. BC has been the better team in the stats (+0.9 vs +0.4 in ypp margin) but VT has been playing better as of late and this is Blacksburg on a Thursday night where they built their brand. We bet VT under the key number of 7 but would pass at current.

MARSHALL 31 Georgia State 23. Weird scheduling spot for Georgia State playing their first game outside the city of Atlanta this season. Marshall led Georgia Southern 23-3 mid-way through the 4Q but lost 24-23 (+1). The Herd had covered their other 5 games this season. We lean OVER with both teams running tempo (GS No. 28, MU No. 43).

Friday, October 18th

DUKE 22 Florida State 20. Duke is 0-20 SU all-time vs FSU but find themselves favored here. FSU has played the more difficult schedule (No. 6 vs No. 97) but their offense is averaging just 14.8 ppg (No. 131). We have competing sharp groups on opposite sides of this game but we don't see value. We'd prefer the dog at +3.5 or more.

Oregon 43 PURDUE 16. Obviously, a terrible spot for Oregon coming off one of their biggest wins in school history upsetting No. 2 Ohio State 32-31 (+3). They're traveling on a short week and Big Ten cross-country travel teams are just 4-9 ATS this season so far. Purdue is off their best performance of the season in a 50-49 OT loss at Illinois. They will stick with QB Ryan Browne who threw for 297 yards and 3 TD's while also running for 118 yards. Our power ratings lean Oregon.

BYU 29 Oklahoma State 22. OSU comes in off a bye after 3 straight losses. They are -103.3 in ypp margin and their season is on the line here. BYU is a perfect 6-0 ATS covering their games by 16.8 ppg. However, they have been outgained in the last 3 games combined. The Wednesday morning forecast is calling for temps in the 40's and rain. That's why we've seen UNDER money. We bet UNDER and OSU.

Fresno State 28 NEVADA 25. Nevada has been a pesky home dog already this season. This is a short week and traveling for Fresno but they outgained Washington State in a loss last week while Nevada was outgained by 140 yards in an upset win over Oregon State. We bet OVER and Nevada but would prefer the total at current.

Saturday, October 19th

IOWA STATE 31 Central Florida 17. Two teams that appear to be heading in opposite directions this season. Iowa State ranks in the Top 17 in ypp, ypg and ppg margins and are the current Big 12 favorite. UCF has good stats but has lost 3 straight and will likely go to QB Jacuri Brown here, their 3rd QB in 3 games. We bet Iowa State.

Wake Forest 29 CONNECTICUT 28. UConn comes in off a bye after a near shocking loss to Temple where they got a 98-yard fumble return TD on the final play. They are the much better team in the stats (+1.1 ypp margin vs -0.8) but Wake has played the tougher schedule (No. 42 vs No. 113). We bet UConn +4.5 on the openers but after a big line move, would lean with Wake now. We bet numbers, not teams!

ARMY 31 East Carolina 19. Army is 6-0 ATS covering by 14.6 ppg but we think you're starting to pay a big premium on their games. A month ago, they were 7.5-point favorites at home to Rice and ECU is a much better team than Rice. Army is No. 6 in ypp margin (+2.9), No. 7 in ypg margin (+195.0) and No. 6 in ppg margin (+29.9). We bet ECU and still lean that way even after a big move.

James Madison 33 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 24. JMU is the much better in the stats (+1.8 ypp margin vs -1.7). They have extra time to prep and Georgia Southern is off a misleading win over Marshall where they rallied from 20 down in the closing minutes. We bet JMU but would pass at the current numbers.

Miami, FL 32 LOUISVILLE 28. Miami comes in off a bye after two very fortunate wins vs Virginia Tech and California that were aided by the replay booth. Still, the Canes have the No. 1 offense in the country averaging 8.1 ypp, 583.8 ypg and 47.7 ppg. We thought Louisville might be primed for an upset here but we haven't liked what we've seen from them in recent weeks. We also don't like the 12:00 start time.

MIAMI, OH 24 Ohio 19. Keep an eye on this Miami team who played a really tough schedule to start (at Northwestern, Cincinnati, at Notre Dame, at Toledo) but are off their best game. Ohio is another sneaky team in the MAC. We haven't bet the game yet.

TEMPLE 27 Tulsa 26. Temple is -1.1 in ypp margin vs the No. 54 schedule while Tulsa is -1.3 in ypp margin vs the No. 95 schedule. That's why the Owls are favored here. We have not bet the game but this will have season win total implications (we have Temple UNDER).

BUFFALO 26 Western Michigan 25. Buffalo pulled their 2nd double-digit outright upset in MAC play this season beating Toledo 30-15 (+10.5) last week. It was a misleading win (see page 1). However, WMU also had a phony final getting outgained by Akron 501-389 in a 10-point win. We lean OVER.

Kentucky 22 FLORIDA 21. Both teams sit at 3-3 and need a win if they are to make a bowl this year. While Florida is better in the stats (+1.3 ypp margin vs 0.0), UK's No. 4 defense is the best unit on the field. Plus, Florida will be starting DJ Lagway at QB with Graham Mertz out for the year and RB Montrell Johnson is also banged up.

Texas State 34 OLD DOMINION 24. Texas St is +1.8 in ypp margin while ODU -0.5. ODU has pulled two outright upsets in recent weeks but we bet Texas State. We prefer UNDER at current numbers as ODU ranks No. 7 in tempo but their offense is inefficient.

NAVY 38 Charlotte 22. Navy comes in off a bye and has a massive ypp margin edge here (+2.1 vs -1.1). Their new OC Drew Cronic has done wonders as the Middies rank No. 3 in ypp and No. 5 in scoring. Charlotte has pulled a couple of upsets in their last two weeks and is also off a bye. We like OVER at current.

Alabama 28 TENNESSEE 27. Both teams are trending in the wrong direction in recent weeks. Both were upset on the road as big favorites two weeks (Bama at Vandy, UT at Arkansas) and both should have lost outright at home last week as big favorites (Bama vs South Carolina, UT vs Florida). Tennessee has not seen an explosive offense like Alabama but the Crimson Tide have to protect QB Milroe from UT's great DL. We bet UNDER at open, but don't mind Tennessee now at +3.

† **Notre Dame 31 Georgia Tech 20.** @ Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta, GA. GT is playing in their home city but this game will be at the Falcons stadium. This is a simple handicap. If GT QB Haynes King does not play, this line will close a few points higher than current. If he plays, he likely won't be 100% and is going up against a ND defense that ranks No. 4 in ypp allowed. We bet ND in what we originally thought would be a tough spot prior to King's injury last week.

UL-Lafayette 31 COASTAL CAROLINA 27. ULL is the better team in the stats (+1.5 vs +0.4 in ypp margin). However, they did have a misleading win vs App State last week and Coastal has extra time to prep. We lean OVER at current.

EASTERN MICHIGAN 28 Central Michigan 25. CMU QB Joey Labas is out for the season and Tyler Jefferson will get the start here. There have been some shenanigans in CMU games as far as the betting markets and the results. CMU is the better team in the stats (+0.3 vs -1.4 in ypp margin) but we're staying away.

CLEMSON 38 Virginia 17. Clemson has quietly won 5 straight games after the blowout loss to Georgia in the openers. The Tigers rank in the top 20 in ypp, ypg and ppg margins. UVA is a much improved team this year but is off a tough loss to Louisville. We're not involved in this game.

CINCINNATI 27 Arizona State 24. Arizona State is 5-1 ATS this season covering by 8.8 ppg. They are the better team in the stats (+1.2 vs +0.4 in ypp margin) and have played the slightly tougher schedule. However, teams traveling across two time zones or more are just 17-24 ATS this season. ASU QB Leavitt is out.

Kansas State 28 WEST VIRGINIA 25. WVU really disappointed us last week in the home loss to Iowa State. Kansas State is making a 2nd straight road trip after a thrilling win at Colorado. Both teams have played tough schedules but Kansas St is better in ypp margin (+1.2 vs +0.3). We haven't bet side or total.

Memphis 38 NORTH TEXAS 27. Typically, this game would scream to bet the OVER and North Texas games are 5-1 to the OVER this year averaging 73.8 total ppg. However, Memphis' defense is legit allowing jsut 15.8 ppg this season (did get exposed vs Navy). NT is the better team in ypp margin (+1.4 vs +0.6) but our ratings lean Memphis.

TEXAS TECH 31 Baylor 25. Both teams come in off a bye. Baylor is the better team in the stats (+0.5 vs +0.1) and has played the tougher schedule (No. 16 vs No. 41). That usually screams a big bet for us when getting a TD but we think their coach is on the way out. Wind and rain is expected.

BOWLING GREEN 38 Kent State 18. Keep an eye on BG QB Connor Bazalak's status. After he went out with injury last week, the Falcons offense couldn't do anything in a 17-7 upset loss at home to NIU. Now they face a Kent State team that is 0-6 SU but did get their first cover of the season in dramatic fashion vs Ball State last week (watch Scott Van Pelt's Bad Beats on ESPN this week). Kent St is dead last in scoring margin but their offense has put up 34 ppg in MAC play so far.

OKLAHOMA 22 South Carolina 20. Both teams need a win if they're going to make a bowl game this year. Both have played Top 10 schedules in terms of difficulty but South Carolina is +0.6 in ypp margin and +62.8 in ypg margin while OU is -0.6 in ypp and -50.1 in ypg. We bet SC and think their DL is the best unit on the field.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS 23 Toledo 21. We think the winner here has the inside track on the MAC championship despite both already getting upset as double-digit favorites vs Buffalo. NIU has the better ypp margin (+1.1 vs +0.6). However, keep an eye on the injury reports as both QB's got banged up in last week's games. Pass for now.

SOUTH FLORIDA 36 Uab 20. Both teams could be playing backup QB's for this game. Both teams are -1.1 in ypp margin. However, USF has played the tougher schedule and we trust their coaching staff more.

RUTGERS 23 UCLA 18. UCLA has played the most difficult schedule in the country so far this season and they keep fighting, clawing and scratching. We do worry after another long road trip, can they keep it up? They're facing an embarrassed Rutgers team who was blown out at home by Wisconsin last week. We bet UCLA on the openers but would pass at current.

Use 33 MARYLAND 24. Lincoln Riley is just 11-10 in his last 21 games at USC. The Trojans fought hard last week vs Penn State but eventually fell in OT. We did not like Riley's clock management at the end of regulation. They're now traveling across the country for the 3rd time already and lost the first two outright to Michigan and Minnesota as favorites. We think USC will fare better here vs a struggling Maryland team off an upset loss to Northwestern.

Michigan 24 ILLINOIS 20. We like the Wolverines here. They come in off a bye and we think the move to Jack Tuttle at QB will open up the pass game. We also think Illinois is a fraudulent 5-1 team as they were nearly upset by lowly Purdue last week. We don't think they match up well at the LOS particularly their OL vs UM's DL.

Wisconsin 25 NORTHWESTERN 17. Keep an eye on this Wisconsin team. They might be starting to figure some things out in Year 2 under Fickell. The Badgers are coming off wins over Purdue and Rutgers by a combined 94-13. They have played the tougher schedule and are +0.7 in ypp margin vs Northwestern's -0.3. The Wildcats are off of a big upset win over Maryland but it was misleading (see page 1).

New Mexico 38 UTAH STATE 37. This is the highest total in CFB this season and at one point this week, it hit 80 (first time that's happened in 3 years). Both teams have Top 30 offenses and bottom 5 defenses. Utah State has played the tougher schedule and has a better ypp margin. However, NM has the coaching edge and the best player on the field in QB Dampier.

UTAH 28 TCU 22. In case you've been living under a rock, Utah QB Cam Rising is out for the season. He does have an 8th year of eligibility but we hope he decides to call it a career especially after last week's outing. TCU is off a bye but HC Sonny Dykes should be on the hot seat. TCU is 1-5 ATS failing to cover by 7.7 ppg. We lean Utah.

Colorado State 27 AIR FORCE 20. AF is 0-6 ATS this season failing to cover by 13.3 ppg. The worst mark of any team in the country. They rank No. 127 in ypp margin. Colorado St is off their best win of the season but did lose WR Horton for the season. Keep an eye on the weather. Early forecast has mid-40's and rain.

SAN JOSE STATE 32 Wyoming 21. We think there is a mis-perception about both teams. Wyoming was a DEAD-UNDER team under Craig Bohl. Now they're running some tempo and are 5-1 to the OVER. San Jose State has a new coach in Ken Niumatalolo...when you think of him, you think option but he's running a high tempo pass-happy offense here.

ARIZONA 29 Colorado 26. Colorado should get back WR's Travis Hunter and Jimmy Horn here after they got hurt vs Kansas State. Omarion Miller another WR who was injured last week, is out for the season. The two teams have played similar schedules and Arizona is +0.7 in ypp while Colorado is +0.5. Lean UNDER.

CALIFORNIA 30 NC State 19. Cal has lost 3 straight games but they could have easily have won all 3, if not for missed kicks and questionable calls. They have played the tougher schedule and are the better team in the stats with a +0.5 ypp margin vs NC State's -0.1. NC State is 0-6-1 ATS failing to cover by 11.4 ppg.

Smu 35 STANFORD 20. Tough spot for Stanford who has made 3 cross-country trips in 4 weeks and are banged after the 49-7 loss to a rested ND team last week. Speaking of rest, SMU is off a bye and are the much better team in ypp margin (+1.1 vs -1.5).

VANDERBILT 42 Ball State 18. Vanderbilt now has 3 outright upsets as a 12.5-point or more underdog this season. This is a different animal though laying a big number after a couple of big-time performances. Plus, QB Diego Pavia was hobbled at the end of the Kentucky game. Ball State games are 6-0 to the OVER by 18.0 ppg but Vandy could play a slow pace here.

KANSAS 27 Houston 21. Both teams come in off a bye. The last time we saw Houston, they were upsetting TCU as a 16.5-point underdog. QB Zeon Chriss could be that missing piece for their offense that has struggled most of the season. Speaking of struggling, Kansas is 0-6 ATS on the season failing to cover by 7.3 ppg. They are the better team in the stats. Could be a sneaky OVER.

Lsu 29 ARKANSAS 27. As of Wednesday morning, it appears Arkansas QB Taylen Green will play after getting hurt late vs Tennessee. The Hogs come in off a bye and are the better team in the stats (+1.2 ypp margin vs +0.9) despite playing a slightly tougher schedule (No. 25 vs No. 31). LSU has had two fortunate wins this season and we'll call for another here.

TEXAS 31 Georgia 27. Another week and another "Game of the Year" in CFB. We have Texas No. 1 in our power ratings now after Ohio State's loss but the Longhorns still haven't played a Top 25 team in our power ratings (Michigan No. 25, Oklahoma No. 27). The Horns are No. 2 in ypp margin and No. 1 in scoring margin. Georgia has not looked the part this season at 1-5 ATS failing to cover by 7.6 ppg. Will we see a full effort out of them here (a la the Clemson game in the opener)? Georgia LB Mondon is likely out and keep an eye on Texas WR Bond. We lean OVER.

TULANE 38 Rice 17. Tulane comes in off a bye. The Green Wave are 5-1 ATS this season covering by 15.3 ppg. They're playing a Rice team that had a dramatic last-second win vs UTSA last week. We bet OVER.

Texas A&M 36 MISSISSIPPI STATE 20. Texas A&M is off a bye. The Aggies have won 5 straight since losing to ND in the opener. They're taking on a pesky Mississippi State team that just plated Texas and Georgia extremely tough. Our ratings lean Texas A&M.

UTSA 30 Fau 24. FAU QB Cam Fancher is dealing with a toe injury and is ? here. Despite playing a similar schedule FAU is 0.0 in ypp margin while UTSA is -0.7. However, with Fancher's unknown status, our ratings like UTSA here. Do note on that on Wednesday afternoon, UTSA started taking a little money.

MISSOURI 27 Auburn 23. Auburn has taken a lot of money this week and we are a part of it. Despite a 2-4 record, vs the No. 36 schedule, Tigers are +2.4 in ypp margin (No. 11) and +106.8 ypp margin (No. 33). TO's have done them in at -11. Meanwhile, 5-1 Missouri playing the No. 111 schedule is only +1.1 in ypp margin.

WASHINGTON STATE 36 Hawaii 19. Despite a 2-4 record, Hawaii is a respectable 0.0 in ypp margin and their defense is legit.. They are allowing just 20.5 ppg and held Boise State's high-powered offense to just 28 points last week. Washington State had a misleading win over Fresno State last week (outgained 338-295). They have played the tougher schedule and are +0.4 in ypp margin. We bet Hawaii.

Unlv 34 OREGON STATE 28. UNLV led Utah State 41-7 at halftime last week but ended up getting back-doored late. We're worried about that defense that looks like it is starting to wear down. The offense actually looks much better with Malik-Williams at QB and is No. 4 in scoring at 45.3 ppg. Oregon State is off a misleading loss to Nevada (see page 1) and we think you'll see a good effort here.

Iowa 24 MICHIGAN STATE 18. Iowa games are 5-1 to the OVER by 7.7 ppg. The Hawkeyes come in off the blowout win over Washington that was misleading (see page 1). MSU is off a bye and has played a similar schedule. The Spartans are +0.7 in ypp while Iowa is +0.8.

Arkansas State 28 SOUTHERN MISS 23. Arkansas State is an over-rated team that despite a 3-3 record are -2.1 in yards per play margin (No. 130). Southern Miss, despite their 1-5 record are -0.7 in ypp margin. We bet Southern Miss and UNDER and still lean that way.

INDIANA 28 Nebraska 23. Indiana has been super impressive this season at 5-1 ATS covering their games by 12.2 ppg. We've upgraded them more than any team in the Power conferences. Their offense is No. 2 in scoring and No. 1 offensive success rate. QB Kurtis Rourke has a 14-to-2 TD-to-INT ratio and is averaging 11.0 yards per attempt (No. 3). However, they haven't played a defense in the Top 60. Nebraska's defense allows just 4.4 yards per play. We haven't bet the game yet but would look at Nebraska +7 or better.

Week 8 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 487-414-14 (54.1%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

This year's record is a pathetic 8-17 so far. Of the 3 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **East Carolina +15.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Denver 20 NEW ORLEANS 17. The two teams have played similar strength of schedules but Denver is +0.3 in ypp margin while New Orleans is -0.8. The two teams are also trending in opposite directions. Despite the loss last week, Denver has won 3 of their last 4 while New Orleans has lost 4 straight, have a backup QB and are dealing with more injuries. The Saints were destroyed in the second half vs Tampa Bay last week. Sean Payton returns to New Orleans and gets a win and cover.

Sunday, October 20th

Jacksonville 23 New England 18. @Wembley Stadium in London, England. We were stunned by that awful performance by the Jags last week. We couldn't have been alone as they went from 2-point underdogs to 1.5-point favorites vs Chicago in the days leading up to kickoff. Now they play their 2nd straight week across the pond vs a New England team that has lost 5 straight games (0-4-1 ATS) and ranks No. 31 in ypp margin at -1.4. We don't have any interest here and actually feel sorry for people of England to have to watch this garbage.

ATLANTA 28 Seattle 26. Atlanta has played the tougher schedule and has the better ypp margin (+0.9 vs +0.2). They're sitting fat and happy off a blowout win over Carolina last week. However, we don't mind the "Buy Low" spot for the Seahawks with extra time to prep off 3 straight losses including to the Lions and 49ers (two of the top 5 teams in anyone's power ratings). Also don't mind the OVER which is 5-1 in Seattle games this year.

BUFFALO 25 Tennessee 17. Tennessee actually has a solid ypp margin (+0.1) while Buffalo is dead-even at 0.0. However, the advanced metrics like DVOA paint a different story with Buffalo No. 7 and Tennessee No. 26 in the league. Buffalo is on a short-week after the critical MNF win over the Jets. We can't back this Tennessee team with Will Levis at QB who came back only to lose outright to the Colts.

Cincinnati 24 CLEVELAND 18. The Browns got a cover last week but still fell to the Eagles. Cleveland is dead last in ypp margin at -1.6 and dead-last in DVOA despite playing the easiest schedule in the NFL so far. Despite a 2-4 record, the Bengals are +0.7 in ypp and easily could be 4-2. They should be motivated to put their state rivals out of misery here. However, it's tough for us to lay this kind of number on the road in division.

GREEN BAY 26 Houston 23. Houston has played the slightly tougher schedule and is +0.9 in ypp margin while Green Bay is +0.8. However, they have some data points without a 100% QB Love. Both had easy blowout wins. They were both dominant in the box score and on the scoreboard while benefiting from TO's. This is a case where we'd like to lay -2.5 or take +3.5. Pass at the current number.

INDIANAPOLIS 24 Miami 20. Miami comes in off the bye at 1-4 ATS. We think their head coach in vastly overrated in the gambling community. The Dolphins are -0.5 in ypp margin. Indianapolis has played the tougher schedule and are +0.1 in ypp margin. The Colts have been underrated in the markets this year at 5-1 ATS and we didn't understand all the love for their opponent Tennessee last week as the Colts won outright. They get another cover here.

MINNESOTA 25 Detroit 24. One of the best matchups of the NFL season so far as the two teams are a combined 9-1 SU and 9-1 ATS. Both are in the top 2 of DVOA (advanced metric). The unbeaten Vikings come in off a bye while Detroit comes in after destroying the Cowboys last week. It was

costly as they lost All-Pro DE Hutchinson for the season. The Vikings have played the tougher schedule than the Lions but Detroit has the better ypp margin (+1.1 vs +0.7). We don't mind Detroit in a teaser here.

Philadelphia 23 N.Y. GIANTS 19. Philly has played the tougher schedule and has the better ypp margin. However, we haven't been that impressed with the Eagles this year which includes a lack-luster win over the feeble Cleveland Browns last week. The Giants were certainly feeble in their 17-7 loss at home to Cincinnati on SNF. Our ratings lean with the Eagles who have owned the series. The two teams are also 8-3 to the UNDER so far this season.

L.A. RAMS 26 Las Vegas 19. Both teams have disappointed so far this season as they come in a combined 3-8 SU and ATS. The Raiders were blown out at home by the Steelers while the Rams come in off a bye. Las Vegas is actually better in ypp margin (-0.5 to -1.1) but the Rams have played one of the most difficult schedules in the league so far while the Raiders have played a bottom 5 schedule. The Raiders' locker-room also has issues.

WASHINGTON 31 Carolina 22. Two franchises heading in opposite directions. The Commanders have found their franchise QB in Jayden Daniels as they are 4-2 SU and 4-1-1 ATS on the season. Carolina is 1-5 SU and ATS and have already benched what was supposed to be their franchise QB. Washington is a full yard per play better in margin. We do prefer the OVER here compared to the side as the two teams are a combined 10-2 to the OVER.

Kansas City 24 SAN FRANCISCO 23. Obviously, one of the biggest games of the regular season matching a rematch of last year's Super Bowl. The unbeaten Chiefs have lived up to the preseason hype on the scoreboard but are only +0.4 in ypp margin. They have played the much tougher schedule than the 49ers who are +1.1 in ypp margin but somehow have lost 3 games outright as a favorite already. Tough not backing Patrick Mahomes as an underdog as he is 11-1-1 ATS in his career. If you can find KC +7.5 in a teaser, we really like that.

PITTSBURGH 20 N.Y. Jets 19. There is a lot of love for the Jets here in this game as they are traveling on a short week after the MNF loss to the Bills. They acquired Davante Adams from the Raiders who reunites with Aaron Rodgers. Russell Wilson looks like he is back under center for the Steelers who are 4-2 SU but are -0.2 in ypp margin (Jets are +0.3 in ypp despite playing a tougher schedule). We'll fade the Jets and we really like the Steelers +8 in a teaser with such a low total.

Monday, October 21st

Baltimore 27 TAMPA BAY 24. Another great game in the NFL this week among Top 10 power-rated teams. The Ravens have won 4 straight and rank No. 1 in ypp margin at +1.3. Tampa is off a blowout win over New Orleans and ranks No. 9 in ypp margin and No. 9 in DVOA. We don't mind taking the hook with the home underdog as something tells us road favorites won't go 9-0 like they did last week in the NFL (best mark since 1970). The two teams are a combined 9-3 to the OVER.

L.A. Chargers 23 ARIZONA 22. We obviously like Jim Harbaugh and what he is doing in L.A. so far. However, this line seems a bit pricey. Arizona is better in ypp margin (-0.1 to -0.3) and the Cardinals have played a Top 5 schedule in terms of difficulty while the Chargers have played a bottom 5 schedule. We think the Cardinals are a good last-leg of a teaser option at +8.5 and wouldn't be surprised if they pulled the outright upset.
