CLOTHING REQUIREMENT: Students are required to wear the light blue Official SkillsUSA work shirt; navy pants and black, brown or tan leather work shoes/boots or Official SkillsUSA t-shirt and jeans (non-baggy, no rips or tears). Skirts and high-heeled shoes are not permitted.

CONTEST UPDATES: All students will take a written test, complete an oral interview, and investigate one crime scene.
