












### Permit Quick Guide

	Must be 15 Years of Age
	Enrolled in an approved Driver's Education Course to receive a CDE form. Notify Insurance Company you have a New Driver
	Show ID Documents from approved list to BMV (Examples in this folder)
	Pass a Written Permit Test
	Pass a Vision Screening Test
	Parent or Guardian to sign off on Financial Responsibility Permits cost \$9.00 (Subject to Change)

### License Quick Guide

	Hold Permit for at least 180 days, and be 16 and 90 days old to take the Drive Test
	Schedule & Pass Drive Skills Test at Driving School (Waiver) or with the BMV. Don't forget to get Stamped & Signed papers before you test.
	Present Drive Log with 50 hours, 10 of those must be at Night. You'll need a copy of Classroom Course Completion Certificate also.
	Parent or Guardian signs for Financial Responsibility.
	Driver's License will cost \$18.00 (Subject to Change)

## WAIVER TIPS

When taking the driving skills test, the following actions may detract from your final score:

- Failing to use defroster or wipers when needed
- Failing to use both hands on the wheel
- Selecting the wrong gear
- Failing to signal
- Driving too slowly for conditions or stopping unnecessarily
- Overrunning a crosswalk, stop line or stop sign
- Failing to check blind spot
- Slowing speed when changing lanes
- Reversing too fast
- Leaving turn signal on after completed lane change
- Driving too closely to the vehicle ahead or a parked vehicle

When taking the driving skills test, the following actions will result in an automatic failure:

- Disobeying a yield, stop, school zone, or no turn on red sign
- Disobeying a traffic signal
- Backing over curb while parallel parking
- Driving into a parked vehicle while parallel parking
- Failure to follow instructions
- Failure to use a seat belt
- Failure to react to hazardous driving conditions
- Speeding
- Driving too fast for conditions
- Turning into or using the wrong lane
- Passing in a no passing zone or otherwise crossing a solid yellow line
- Driving left of center
- Straddling marked lanes
- Driving too close to pedestrians or bicycles
- Pass school bus with arm out
- Failure to pull over and stop for emergency vehicles or school buses
- Causing an accident during a driving skills test
- Failure to yield the right-of-way
- Failure to obey required laws concerning RR crossings
