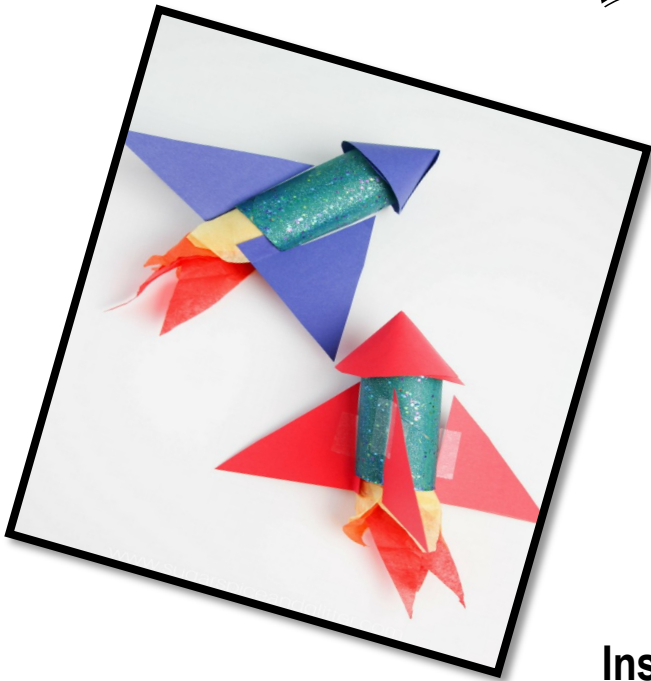

# PAPER ROCKETS

### Materials Included:

- Rocket craft printable
- Cardboard tube

### Materials You Need to Gather From

#### Home:

- Paints or Markers
- Scissors

### Instructions

1. Paint or color the paper tube. This is the base of your rocket!
2. While the paint is drying, color and cut out the shapes from the rocket craft printable. (If you want to make your rocket stand up, give it an extra fin!).
3. Cut one line of the circle (nose cone of the rocket) and glue or tape all over the triangle section. Fold the glued section underneath the rest of the circle to form a cone and let dry.
4. Cut the streamers to form the "flames" to come out of the bottom of the rocket.
5. When the nose cone and paper tube are dry, attach the fins (either by cutting halfway down the rectangular lines and inserting the paper tube in the cuts, or folding the rectangular tabs down and taping or gluing them to the rocket).
6. Attach the nose cone and optional "rocket windows."
7. Tape or glue the flames securely to the inside of the rocket and you're done - 3, 2, 1 BLAST OFF!
