

<b>Zucchini Squash</b>			
in color order - lightest to darkest			
Zuchino da Fiore San Pasquale	annual	heirloom	A zucchini plant bred and grown for its prolific flowering - not much fruit if any! Almost all flowers are male. An Italian Heirloom for blossom production.
Zucchini, Lungo Blanco	annual	heirloom	A very pale yellow zucchini - long and curved with nice ribbing for very attractive star shapes when sliced. Tender skin, mild flavor.
Rugosa Friulana Crookneck Squash	annual	heirloom	A productive and dependable yellow squash - Pale yellow warted skin - Delicious with tender skin despite the warting when eaten young.
Yellow Crookneck	annual	f1	As is common with crooknecks, production is fabulous and fruits are tender and delicious. This is a pale yellow color with a smooth skin.
Zephyr (yellow with green tips)	annual	f1	Flavorful - dual colored squash! One of my favorites and most dependable. This is a tender skinned crookneck - bright yellow and jewel toned green.
Zucchini, Gold Mine (Yellow Squash)	annual	f1	Very buttery flavor - good strong hybrid bright yellow. This also has a nice ribbing.
Zucchini, Gold Rush (Yellow Squash)	annual	f1	A bright yellow and smooth golden zucchini.
Zucchini, Genovese	annual	heirloom	Good flavor - light colored pale green version of the classic zucchini with great heirloom flavor.
Zucchini, Fiorentino	annual	heirloom	Very buttery flavor - pale green with prominent ribbing creating the star shaped slices. Wonderful heirloom flavor.
Trombicino Rampicante	annual	heirloom	A vine style heirloom squash - prolific - beautiful long curving light green color. Buttery flavor. Giant squashes - can be carried over the shoulder. Entire neck is seedless. If left on the vine, flesh will turn darker and sweeter and skin will get harder, making it a better storage squash.
Zucchini, Dunja	annual	f1	This is a f1 developed by Johnny's Seeds. It is a medium colored green classic zucchini and is perfect for gardeners who have had issues with disease such as downy mildew...
Zucchini, Costata Romanesca	annual	heirloom	Dark green heirloom with stripes. Great squash flavor. Sometimes can be hard to see out in the garden!
Zucchini, Striato d'Italia	annual	heirloom	Very similar to the Romanesca - dark green heirloom with stripes.
Zucchini, Nero di Milano	annual	heirloom	Dark dark - shiny - almost black - heirloom. A beautiful squash.

Squash, Summer, Patty Pan Flying Saucer	annual	heirloom	Very variegated yellow and dark green

<b>Squash, Summer, Patty Pan, Pattison Panache "Jaune et Verte"</b>	annual	heirloom	Creamy white, green striped, scalloped fruits Highly productive Good eating qualities when young, rock-hard ornamental when fully mature
<b>Squash, Summer, Patty Pan, Pattison Panache "Verte et Blanc"</b>	annual	heirloom	Sea-foam green fruits mature to white with dark green stripes Excellent when eaten young Highly productive
<b>Squash, Summer, Patty Pan G-Star</b>	annual	f1	Dark shiney green all over
<b>Squash, Summer, Patty Pan Peter Pan or Bennings Grren Tint</b>	annual	heirloom	Light green
<b>Squash, Summer, Patty Pan Y-Star</b>	annual	f1	Yellow with light green markings
<b>Squash, Patty Pan, Pure White</b>	annual	heirloom	Pure white
<b>Tonda di Piacenza</b>	annual	heirloom	A round zucchini!
