I love living in this part of the country where we get to enjoy and experience the activities four seasons offer. Summer is the best. Saturday after unpacking from a week at camp Laurelview and sharing the details with Jan I kicked back in my easy chair for a nap. Windows open and our windchimes singing Summertime Breeze right in tune with music on the stereo. 
