Course Title: Kindergarten

Course Length: Fall & Spring Semesters

Curriculum: My Father's World-Kindergarten

Course Title: Brain Training

Course length: Fall & Spring Semesters

Course length: Fall and Spring Semester

Course Title: Elementary Music K-5th

Course Length: 1 Year
