MEETING MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER

The River City Cruisers Car Club meeting was held at the city park on September 25, 2018 with 20 members present.

The meeting was called to order by President Doug Smith and Lynn Mead reported a balance of \$8816.66.

CAR SHOW

We were down on entries from last year, we had about 95 cars registered this year. Total profit was \$2605.63 which is about half of last year.

Breakdown on expenses/income:

- * Trophies—sponsorship income of \$2700 and cost to club was \$1862.91 (glasses and etching done for 2019)
- * T-shirts—sponsorship income of \$1200, sales were \$430, and cost to club was \$704
- * Quilt—income of \$106 and cost to club was \$46.70
- * 50/50—income of \$624 (about the same as last year)
- * Saturday night BBQ—cost to club was \$362.48
- * Food Stand—income of \$1375 and cost to club was \$720
- * Registration—income of \$1110 day of show plus \$450 in pre-registers
- * Miscellaneous—flyers, dash plaques, sound system, shuttle, ads, etc.—cost to club of around \$415

The drive-thru payment worked well, we didn't have any complaints. There was discussion on raising the registration price next year to \$20 day of show instead of \$15, display only will raise to \$10 instead of \$5, and pre-register will stay the same at \$10. This was voted on by the member present and approved.

There was also discussion regarding sponsors. Instead of approaching businesses for sponsoring trophies or t-shirts, present as sponsoring the car show in general. We can present to the businesses to help with expenses overall (trophies, t-shirts, sound system, food, kids prizes, etc).

Last year we talked about giving t-shirts sponsors a shirt and if we are dismissing the trophy sponsors doing this. It was discussed and Dale Straatmann suggested we go ahead and give them shirts and everyone agreed.

Everyone was unsure what time the pedal car races were going to start so a suggestion was made to have some flyers at the registration table.
