**Chalk Walk 101** – Help us create 101 feet of contiguous sidewalk chalk art at Chalk Walk & ArtsFest on Saturday, August 4. Free to participate; advance registrants receive chinks at the event. First 31 to register are guaranteed space in Chalk Walk 101. Once that space is filled, registrants will be assigned to various business locations in downtown Dansville.

1. All **community chalk artists** who register **BY JULY 27** will receive pastel sidewalk chinks at the event. All ages and abilities are welcome. Those under age 13 must be supervised by an adult. That adult should list him/herself as the contact person on the registration form. There is **NO** registration or participation fee.
2. First 31 to register are guaranteed space in Chalk Walk 101. Once that space fills, registrants will be assigned a location in historic downtown Dansville. Pick up chinks and receive your chinking location at Dansville ArtWorks, 153 Main (after 9:45am on August 4). **Chinking starts at 10am sharp.**
3. Chinking in a group and want adjacent squares? Please indicate this on your form and we will **do our best** to place you **next to or near** each other\*.
4. This is a rain or shine event!! In the event of rain, we will provide and you will work on large format craft paper inside Dansville ArtWorks starting at 10am.
5. Your participation may be noted on signage or the event map and other media related to the event. By submitting your application, you allow Dansville ArtWorks to use your name, image and artwork with respect to the event and promotion thereof for no compensation. You assume all risks by participating in this event and release from any and all liability Dansville ArtWorks, its board, employees, volunteers and landlord, owners of participating properties, their boards, employees and volunteers, Village of Dansville, Town of North Dansville, and all event sponsors, their boards, employees and volunteers.
