May 13, 2018 Seventh Sunday of Easter John 17:11b-19

"As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world."

Historians have identified a common trait of great leaders. It is not their strategy or tactics, although those are important. It is not that they assembled overwhelming numbers of soldiers against an inferior enemy. It is that they lead from the front. King Leonidas at the front of three hundred Spartans at Thermopylai; Alexander the Great; George Washington; and Andrew Jackson all lead their men into battle. They did not ask others to take more risk than they were willing to take themselves. They lead from the front. God the Father sent His Son into the world to teach us by His Actions and by His Words to go into the world and to lead others to follow Him by imitating Him. Jesus is the Word and the Truth. He taught us the Truth with his Word. He showed us the Truth in his Actions. Jesus lead from the front. When we acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God and imitate him, he is in us and we are him and he is in the world. Have we followed him? Are we still following? Will we lead others to him? Do we lead from the front?
