One of the things that I have really enjoyed doing over the last couple of months is continuing the online devotions from the book of

Psalms. They have been as beneficial to me as I hope they have to you. Last week, in Psalm 125, the psalmist talked about three different people and their approach to the Word of God. One group are the faithful, committed people who follow God and live for him. Another group are those who willfully choose to reject God. In the middle are those Christians who compromise their commitment because they want to do what they want rather than what the Bible says they should do. In response to my comments, someone asked me if I had some sin specific sin in mind when I talked about how some Christians rationalize bad behavior.

I wanted to clarify that I was talking in broad, general terms. As Christians we will sometimes disagree on what is sin and what isn't sin. But as long as we agree on our commitment to Christ, we can continue to stay together and be the church. We are each responsible to God for our relationship with God. It is not my place or anyone else's to judge or criticize what another Christian does. Remember to be humble. I hope this helps clarify some things.
