Namaste Raj,

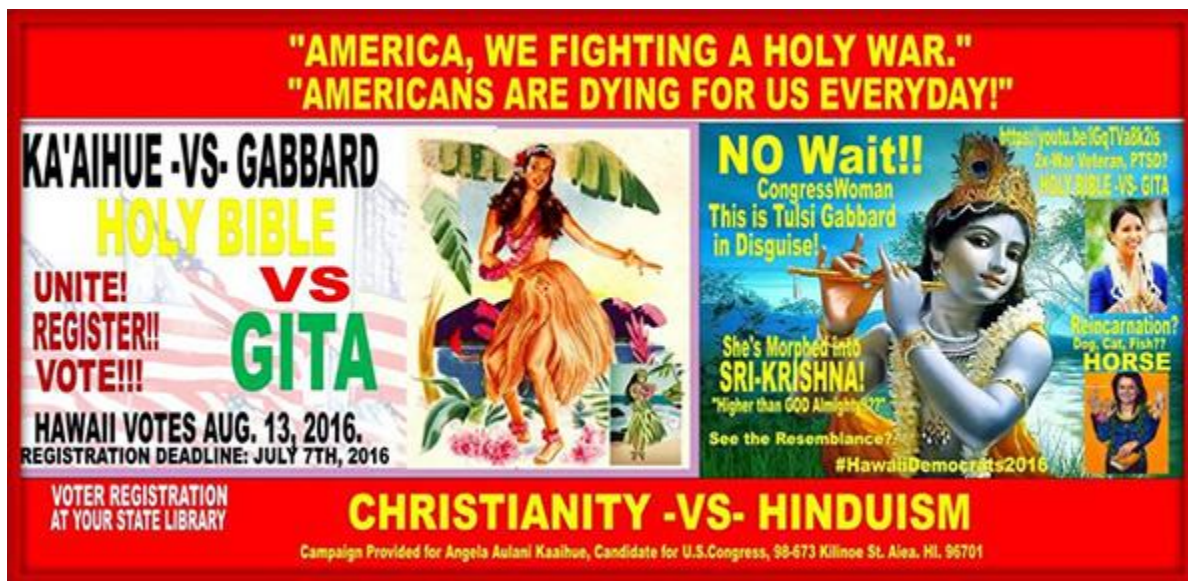
