



## How to Join the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Composite Squadron for Prospective Senior Members

We are honored that you have decided to join B-CC! Civil Air Patrol has so many amazing opportunities for senior members and we are happy to see that you have chosen to take advantage of them!

Before you submit your membership application, make sure you have completed the following:

- ✓ Attended a minimum of 3 squadron meetings
- ✓ Had your official identification inspected by the Squadron Commander or designee
  - Examples include: Driver's License/State ID, U.S. passport, Social Security Card, Certified copy of Birth Certificate, current alien registration receipt card (Form I-151 or I-551), etc.
- ✓ Spoken with the Squadron Commander or recruiting staff about any special needs/accommodations you may have

Complete your membership application

1. Go to [https://www.gocivilairpatrol.com/media/cms/F\\_12\\_FAAE032949645.pdf](https://www.gocivilairpatrol.com/media/cms/F_12_FAAE032949645.pdf)
2. Print out a copy of the form, complete all applicable sections using black ink, and ensure that you write legibly.
  - a. Under the box "Charter Number" enter: **MAR-MD-071**
3. Provide the completed form to the Squadron Commander for review and signature.
4. All prospective Senior Members are subject to an FBI background check before applications are approved by National Headquarters. Fingerprinting can be done at Squadron meetings for free if appropriate personnel are available, otherwise you can seek out fingerprinting at other local police stations.
5. National dues for Senior Members are \$65 and can be paid via Check payable to "Civil Air Patrol"
6. Mail your completed/signed application, fingerprint card, and dues payment to:
