

## Change to Club By-laws – Passed by Membership 1 December, 2015

### Club Officers: Article VI

Current By-laws requires club members running for an elected club office to have participated in at least 60% of club activities. These include: club meetings, club shoots, parties & socials, and volunteer events during the current election year. The reasoning given for this requirement was to insure the club officers were active in the club. We have found, however, that many active club members who desire to run for an elected club office do not meet this requirement because they travel during the year to other shoots or/and because their employment doesn't allow them to attend some of the required meetings or/and events. In 2014, for example, the club did not have anyone eligible for Club Secretary and Territorial Governor, and this current year the club has gone without a Range Master. Club members who travel promote the club and its major shoots which benefit the club. No additional "points" are given for this, as well as for those who take on the task of being the Match Director for major club shoots; to those who set up the stages twice a month for the club's monthly matches; or to those club members who devote endless hours at the range keeping it in good repair. Because of this, many club members believe this requirement needs to be changed.

#### Article VI, Section I: Club Officers:

3. Club Officers must be filled by persons who have been a member of the Club for a minimum of one (1) year ~~and have participated in at least 60% of club activities (club meetings, club shoots, parties & socials, and volunteer events) during the current year.~~
