

- 5. Carry out the administrative duties authorized by the Zoning Ordinance,
- 6. Make studies, investigations and surveys relative to short- and long-term issues concerning Menominee Township;
- 7. Prepare and submit a detailed budget to the Township Board for approval;
- 8. Develop, at a conceptual level, specific projects recommended to help implement township plans and policies;
- 9. Adopt bylaws and such standing rules as it feels necessary for the effective and efficient functioning of the Planning Commission.

B. The Commission shall have authority to apply for and receive grants from any government agency or the federal government and to receive gifts.

110. Meetings; Record

The Commission shall adopt bylaws for the transaction of business and shall keep a record of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations, which records shall be a public record.

111. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect 63 days after the Ordinance is published by the Township Board in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township, unless a legal referendum petition is filed as provided by the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, Public Act 33 of 2008, as amended, M.C.L. 125.3801, *et seq.*, and then when the establishment of a planning commission has been approved by a majority of the electors voting at the next regular or special election that allows reasonable time for proper notices and printing ballots, or at any special election called for that purpose, as determined by the Township Board.
