

intentional evangelism initiative

BLESS is an approach to prayer and evangelism initiated by the Evangelical Covenant Church. It focuses on five missional practices that we can engage to naturally introduce people to Jesus Christ. BLESS stands for **B**egin with prayer, **L**isten with care, **E**at Together, **S**erve in Love, and **S**hare your story. Each practice represents the development of relationships through which evangelism can more naturally occur. We will begin the BLESS initiative here at Dawson Covenant Church on Sunday, April 8. Pastor Erik will also lead a Wednesday night adult study to coincide with our Sunday morning lessons.

HOLY BAPTISM



WEEK OF PRAYER 2018

For more than 60 years, the Evangelical Covenant Church has provided materials for a week of prayer. Whether you choose to use this resource at the beginning of the year or at some other time, the intent is to both challenge and equip followers of Jesus to live a life of prayer and to continually seek new ways to develop this life-giving practice. Everyone in the congregation should have received a copy of the Week of Prayer booklet in their church mailbox. There are several extra copies on the table in the entry way as well. This year's prayer booklet is extra special to Dawson Covenant Church because it was authored by Lauren Carlson.

This resource invites us to practice prayer in ordinary life. We are called to pray without ceasing, but in today's hurried life this is difficult. Lauren helps us to see ways we can pray focused prayers as we go about our daily and weekly routines. Allow your daily encounters with water to bring prayers of justice, liberation, baptism, life, faith, and hearing from God into your daily routine.



COVENANT YOUTH OF ALASKA

Covenant Youth of Alaska (CYAK) is our mission of the month. CYAK is a relational outreach, discipleship, and leadership ministry for Alaska youth and young adults. Part of understanding CYAK's mission, vision, and values, and what they do, involves understanding the context in which the ministry is working.



The Context: Alaska is BIG! Its so big, that every man, woman and child in America could have one acre of land, and there still would be 800,000 acres of wilderness remaining! If you superimpose a map of Alaska over the lower 48 states, Alaska would reach from the East to the West. A large number of the state's population of 660,000 is made up of people living in rural villages which can only be accessed by plane, boat, or snowmachine.

The Challenge: Alaska Native youth have some of the highest rates of suicide, teen pregnancy and sexual abuse in the country. The United Nations considers the death by violent accident rate equivalent to a war zone. Because of various reasons including Alaska's remote geographical location, the struggles of Alaska Native people groups are not on the national radar.

Our Response: In 1992, Covenant Youth of Alaska was formed in response to this crisis through the Evangelical Covenant Church of Alaska (now the Alaska Conference of the Evangelical Covenant Church). Today, CYAK works in collaboration with churches and ministries for the cause of ministry to young people in Alaska.

You can get involved in the ministry in Alaska by praying, donating or serving. Find out more at cyak.org. A special offering will be collected in support of this mission throughout the month of April.


