Premiums will be paid as follows: 1st – 30 pts., 2nd – 25 pts., 3rd – 20 pts., 4th – 15 pts., 5th – 10 pts., and 6th – 5 pts. No premiums will be paid for Grand and Reserve Champion or Showmanship classes. Showmanship class ages will be as of date of show. Medals will be awarded for Lead Line entries and Showmanship winners will receive a plaque.. **Lead Line participants must be unable to ride without a parent or guardian. If an exhibitor enters the Lead Line division they cannot other riding divisions.**

IMPORTANT: Horses will check in between 4:00 and 5:30 pm on Tuesday, July 24th. They must have a Negative Coggins Test and will not be allowed on the Fairgrounds until an EIA Inspector checks this test. The Inspector will be available at 4:00 pm. at the entrance of the Fairgrounds. **If Horses are found on the fairgrounds prior to this time, they will be disqualified and cannot enter the Horse Show.**

Supreme Horseman Awards – New Awards

A Supreme Horseman buckle and a Horse Neck Ribbon will be awarded to the High Point winner in the Fulton County Fair Horse Show. This award will be based on points earned by Fulton County Junior Exhibitors, who participate in the Western Pleasure, Trail, Showmanship, Barrels and Poles competitions. There will be two age divisions age 9-13 and age 14-18. 1st place will earn 6 points, 2nd place – 5 points, 3rd place – 4 points, 4th place – 3 points, 5th place – 2 points, and 6th place – 1 point.

Austin’s Paint & Quarter Horses will sponsor the Reserve Supreme Horseman Award.

Out of County Exhibitors use Divisions 200, 201, 202, 203, and 204 for entries.
