By signing and submitting this application, applicant agrees to comply with all applicable Village Ordinances, State and Federal Laws, and represents he/she will at all times comply with the following rules when operating the non-highway vehicle:

1. When operating on a street, road, alley, or highway, the non-highway vehicle shall have its headlight and tail lamps lighted at all times when rain, snow, fog or other atmospheric conditions require the use of windshield wipers, and any other times when due to insufficient light or other unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the streets, roads and alleys are not clearly discernable at a distance of one thousand (1,000) feet.

2. A non-highway vehicle may only be operated from sunrise to sunset, nonhighway vehicles may not be operated between sunset and sunrise.

3. The operator of a non-highway vehicle must operate the vehicle in compliance with all Village Ordinances and the provisions of the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/10101, et. Seq.), as amended from time to time.

4. A non-highway vehicle may not be operated at a speed in excess of 20 mph.

5. A non-highway vehicle may only be operated on streets where the posted speed is 35 miles per hour or less.

6. A non-highway vehicle may not be operated on sidewalks or other public property not accessible to or authorized for vehicular traffic.

7. A non-highway vehicle may not be driven on a State highway; except, a nonhighway vehicle may make a direct crossing over a State highway at an intersection controlled by a traffic light or a 4-way stop sign if the speed limit on the highway is 35 mph or less at the place of crossing.
