# SIKKEMA & NELSON REPEAT AS CHAMPIONS

### SIKKEMA & NELSON BOTH EARN 2nd STRAIGHT TOUR TRIUMPHS

If there's a feeling of déjà vu after this month's GISBT event, it can be easily explained. For the 2nd month in a row, Seth Sikkema and Addy Nelson were crowned as tour champions. That's an instant replay from last month in Waterloo. The last time the same pair of winners repeated as champions came in November 2017 in Muscatine, when Adam Morse and Nicole Petersen won for the 2nd straight month.

There was a major difference, however. Last month; both were victorious on a low scoring challenging lane pattern, and this month, both won in a high scoring shootout. And when Sikkema, a 2-hander from Fulton, Illinois,, gets his big strike ball rolling, he's simply one of the most powerful players on tour. This was Sikkema's 3rd trip to the GISBT Winner's Circle.

Sikkema set the building ablaze during his qualifying round by averaging 259.12 for his 8 games – and this represents the 4th highest qualifying score in the 28-season history of the GISBT. Included in this strike barrage was a 299 game, with his bid for perfection stopped only by an insane solid 7-pin. The hot shooting enabled Sikkema to cart a 146-pin lead into match play, and although his pace slowed considerably during the finals, he was never headed, with his final margin of victory being 149 pins.

This was his 12th match play finals appearance. For his 16 games, he averaged 241.50. His spoils consisted of the championship plaque and a \$350 scholarship. Congratulations, Seth!

### DAY OF HIGH SCORES PRODUCES 4 300's, A 299 AND AN 803

The Big Ben 44 foot lane pattern produced some great scores at this month's tour stop. William Jones began his day with an impressive 803 series, while a quartet of 300 games came early in qualifying; those were authored by Christin Swank, Addy Nelson, Dale Weaver and Evan Miller. And as mention earlier, Seth Sikkema cranked out that 299 game as well. All 676 games averaged a whopping 206.71 for the day.

### POWERFUL CROWE EARNS RUNNER-UP IN TOUR DEBUT

Cameron Crowe made a strong statement in his GISBT debut. The hard-throwing lefty from Orland Park, Illinois was this month's runner-up finisher, taking home a \$225 scholarship. Crowe, already a champion on the Illinois, Indiana and E.Y.T. tours, was appearing in his first-ever GISBT stop, and was strong throughout. He qualified in 5th place at +256, and vaulted into the runner-up spot by posting the best match play round average – a 232.37 mark for his 8 matches, winning 5 and losing 3 of them.

### PAST CHAMP MILLER FINISHES 3rd

Past tour winner Evan Miller was this month's 3rd place finisher; he won \$175. Miller has enjoyed a great start to the 2019-2020 campaign, qualifying for the finals in all 3 events. Overall; this was his 5th match play finals appearance.

For the 2nd time this season, the Sioux Falls, South Dakota native posted a 300 game. Miller achieved that feat at the season opener in Cedar Rapids, and this month, reached that number again in his qualifying round.

### WOLF PLACES 4th

Avery Wolf continued his fine season by finishing 4th; he captured a \$150 scholarship. The 19 year-old southpaw from Skokie, Illinois, was making his 2nd straight, and his 3rd career match play finals appearance. He logged the best finish of his tour career – a 3rd place showing – at last month's event in Waterloo.

### JONES FINISHES 5th

William Jones made it 2-for-2. The talented tweener from Anoka, Minnesota competed in his 2nd career GISBT event, and has now qualified for the match play finals in both; he finished 8th at the season opener in Cedar Rapids. Jones began his day with a fantastic 803 series by stringing games of 280, 266 and 257.

### SOLONKA STAKES 6th

Dakota Solonka, a powerful 2-hander from Indianapolis, Indiana was this month's 6th place performer; he earned a \$130 scholarship for his day's work. Solonka, one of 3 past champions in this month's boy's finals field, was appearing in the 6th match play finals of his career, and he is one of 3 tour members – along with Evan Miller and Addy Nelson on the girl's side – to qualify for the finals in all 3 events this season.

### LEFTIES LINKE & MONNENS TIE FOR 7th

A pair of southpaws rounded out this month's boy's finals field. Braydn Linke and Jordan Monnens tied for 7th place, each carting home a \$115 scholarship for their efforts. Linke, a smooth-stroker from Harrisville, Utah, and Monnens, a powerful 2-hander from Ham Lake, were both appearing in just the 2nd GISBT events of their promising careers.

The high game out of the money this month went to Lucas Kramer, who logged a nice 286 during his qualifying from. The right-hander from Marshalltown, Iowa took home a \$55 scholarship.

# NELSON EARNS BACK-TO-BACK TITLES

### NELSON WINS AGAIN, HOLDS OFF SWANK IN STRIKE-FEST

Addy Nelson is enjoying one of the finest career starts in GISBT history. After a 4th place finish at the season opener in August, the 19 year-old has now logged back-to-back trips to the Winner's Circle. Last month, the smooth-stroker from Gregory, South Dakota posted a dominant 312-pin win on a demanding lane condition. This time out, she prevailed over a stellar finals field in a high-scoring shootout, proving her versatility on the lanes.

The right-hander also enjoyed a career highlight by firing her first career 300 game during her qualifying round. That helped her qualify in 3rd place, but picked up the pace during match play by averaging 235.33 for her 6 games, and posting 4 wins to go along with a pair of losses.

Nelson became the 19th player in the girl's division to earn back-to-back championships. The most recent was Megan Hess, who captured last season's February and March events. She bagged a \$250 scholarship for her victory. For her 14 games, she averaged 227.07. Congratulations, Addy!

### SWANK TAKES RUNNER-UP FINISH

Christin Swank was this month's runner-up finisher, earning a \$175 scholarship in the process.

Swank, a 4-time tour winner and former GISBT Bowler of the Year, was in hot pursuit of Nelson the entire day. She was the first player to notch a 300 on the high scoring day, logging the first perfect game of her career in game #2 of her qualifying round.

Swank stayed close to the eventual winner, and eventually closed the gap to just 44 pins. Swank and Nelson enjoyed a couple of great matches; in game #2, Nelson stopped Swank 279-259, but Swank returned the favor during the position round by hanging a 255-244 defeat on the champion. For Swank, this marked the 19th match play finals of her stellar tour career. She now has 4 career runner-up finishes to accompany her 4 tour titles.

### QUALIFYING LEADER HESS FINISHES 3rd

Megan Hess was this month's 3rd place finisher; the right-hander from Granger, Iowa hauled in a \$150 scholarship by virtue of her performance. Hess garnered this month's high qualifier medal by averaging 229.50 for her first 8 games. Hess, in career finals appearance #9, earned a \$150 scholarship for her finish.

### CRAFT CLAIMS 4th

Nicole Craft was in great form this month, returning to the finals for the 6th time in her career. The Omaha, Nebraska native finished 4th, taking home a \$130 award for her performance.

### DUVER REACHES 30th CAREER FINALS, FINISHES 5th

Hanna Duver reached a milestone at this month's tour stop by becoming just the 13th player – male or female – to reach 30 career match play finals. Duver, a 2-time tour champion from Indianola, Iowa, made her tour debut back in March 2010 at age 10. This month, she earned a \$120 scholarship by finishing 5th.

### MAGSAM 6th IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

Keira Magsam enjoyed a breakthrough performance at this month's event. The talented right-hander from Gretna, Nebraska, has been one of the talked-about players since debuting on tour at the tender age of 10 four seasons ago. This month, she qualified for her very first match play finals at the age of 13, and that easily made her the youngest of this month's half-dozen match play finalists. She won a \$110 scholarship for her efforts, and years from now, she'll most likely look back on this month's finish as a springboard to a springboard to a stellar GISBT career.

This month's high game out of the money was awarded to Abbey Fangman, from Waterloo, Iowa. She stroked an impressive 268 game during her qualifying block to take home the \$55 scholarship.
