

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2019-31**

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING SHANE OLSON’S SALARY AS A POLICE SERGEANT FOR AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor of Amelia Village, after conferring with the Police Chief, has recommended that after the completion of the probationary period of Shane Olson as a full time Police Sergeant for Amelia Village, that he receive a pay increase; and

**WHEREAS**, The Council of Amelia Village concurs that Shane Olson should receive a wage increase for his work as a full time Amelia Village Police Sergeant

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

**SECTION I.** Shane Olson who is employed as a full time Police Sergeant of Amelia Village and has completed the required probationary period, will receive an increase of salary to \$51927.60 effective May 27, 2019 with all other terms of his employment remaining as provided pursuant to Ordinance O-2018-35.

**SECTION II.** Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is to ensure timely payment to Sergeant Shane Olson who has completed his required probationary period. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MS. RUMKE moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MR. FISCHER seconded the motion.
