The Board has approved a minor change to our constitution, clarifying our mission statement in support our 501(c)(3) non-profit status. We would like to add Provisions E an F to the Constitution, Article II, objects as follows:

E. Further: IWLA York Chapter No. 67 is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

F. Further: Upon the dissolution of IWLA York Chapter No. 67, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to a state or local government, for a public purpose. "

This must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the voting members present at the May election.

STREAM RESTORATION PROJECTS

YORKIWLA #67 is the project management team for several state and federally sponsored stream restoration construction projects in southern York county. We are are a liaison between contractors and the various government granting agencies.

This work greatly benefits the local area streams, with the aim to reduce sediment down stream, and increase the health of fish habitat. A great local example of the work being done is the stretch along Swamp Road near the club. Only half of that stretch has been restored so far, and the difference is amazing. The other half is on the list of upcoming projects.

We have the exciting probability of several new construction phase projects starting in 2020. We are looking for folks to help with project management, accounting and minor field work (like inspections and tree plantings), as well as community relations, in cooperation with these projects. This is the kind of conservation effort the Izaak Walton League stands for, and all of these projects are local to the club. If you are interested, please drop me an email or phone call. — Gary



3-GUN Three gun action matches are exciting and fast-paced, and require competitors to be extremely familiar with rules and procedures before participating in matches. If you've never seen a real 3 gun match we invite you to come see one (bring eye and ear protection) and introduce yourself. We'll be happy to answer questions and get you pointed in the right direction. We follow the Midatlantic 3 gun rules.

Pre-registration is mandatory for all York 3-Gun action matches. Sign-up for the 3-Gun at York is announced on the blogspot about 5 days before each match and is required. Email your





USPSA USPSA is a fast-paced, action-packed sport based on accuracy, power and speed. Shooters compete in one of eight divisions using either a pistol, revolver or pistol caliber carbine (PCC). Beginners are welcome, but you must be able to safely draw a handgun, perform reloads and navigate our courses of fire. If you have never shot an action

shooting match (USPSA, IDPA, 3-gun, etc.) before you will be required to attend a pre-match safety briefing prior to your first match. USPSA has an extensive set of safety rules; we highly recommend reviewing them before your first match. The competition rules can be found on the USPSA website: https://uspsa.org. Registration for each match will be via Practiscore at https://practiscore.com/clubs/york_uspsa and will open a week before the match. Scores will be posted to Practiscore. We will also post registration information and scores to the blog. See more info on our webpage www.yorkiwla.org/uspsa.html.

FALLING STEEL The dates for Falling Steel at York this year are:

Saturday, April 11th • Sunday, May 3rd • Sunday, July 5th Sunday, August 2nd (PA Falling Steel Championship)

The first 3 matches will be 5 stages and \$20 entry. The last one will be 6 or 7 stages and it will cost \$40, but include cash prizes. All 4 matches will allow multiple entries within the same time slot, teams, lots of divisions with high cap or 10 round limits, and PCCs with almost no limitations to capacity or configuration.



Changes for this year include the steel will be painted white after every squad, some wider arrays, ipad scoring, and no shotguns. Applications for the August match will be available by April match.
