President's Message

CONGRATULATIONS! Boone Barrow 2012/2013 Player of the Year

WOW! What a great start to the new 2013/2014 EMPC season, we had 88 players in the 1st tournament of the year, with several new members and previous members who were gone for a year or more and rejoined: Brian Dancses and Kirk Dancses, Brian King, Randy Reynolds "Welcome back"! We also had two new members play in the tournament: Gordon Reel and Michael Muscare. Welcome to EPMC!

At the last board of directors meeting, the handicap committee with the approval of the board looked at several members' handicaps and past history as they related to their tournament scores. We adjusted two members' handicaps to fairly represent their potential in our tournaments. This was not done arbitrarily and no one was being picked on. It is the handicap committee's responsibility to maintain a fair and level playing field in our tournaments, and we will be looking at all members that play at a handicap higher than their potential in the future.

We have had issues with the sign-ups for our tournaments. The course needs to have enough time to sell tee times that we don't use. We have always allowed signups as late as the Monday or Tuesday before the tournament, but this has caused problems with the pairings and made it more difficult for the course to schedule weekend tournaments and public tee times. To eliminate this and to allow the course to have the opportunity to sell out the tee times, and to take the pressure off of the tournament director and his ability to do the pairings, we are changing the sign-up process. Effective with the November tournament the deadline for signing-up is the Saturday prior to the tournament, this applies to the entry form dropped at the Golf shop and E-Mails.

At the next board of directors meeting we will decide on the formats for next year's tournaments. We welcome any input from the membership.

Tournament News

Seems we had another successful Tournament. We had a total of 88 players tee it up on Chino Creek for a fine day of 2 man Scramble. Congratulations to the winners in A flight a two way tie at 62 were the teams Rick Kerian/Richard Lizarraga and Brian Dancses/Kirk Dancses. Taking the B flight all alone in first at 58.5 was the team of Robert Johns/Tom Canfield. Way to go! Welcome to all our new members and returning members. Let's see you all out again next month at the Individual Low net.

I was asked to write some informational things instead of just repeating the winners so when I was auditing the scorecards I thought I would pass on some of the issues and observations I have from both auditing and check in table.

- 1. There were 4 math errors (none of which affected the Tournament outcome but you never know....©
- 3 cards did not indicate the player required 6 tee balls. (one of those cards had a math error and came within ½ stroke of placing after the correction) It would have been a shame to DQ them for not indicating the tee balls.

Now for some tips on scoring:

- 1. Keep the Player/Team score on one line. The line designated with the players name.
- 2. Use the Team/Net line when designated.
- 3. Do Not keep other team/player scores on the same card unless designated. Please grab another card if you want to keep your own or the other team/player scores on the side.
- 4. Clearly mark drive count with an x, check mark, dot, player initial or other clearly annotated method. (one team marked x's on the front and then switched to initials on the back). It never hurts to go one more hole than the required 6 in case of controversy.

Check in table tips:

- 1. Don't check in before the table is open (usually 7 am).
- 2. Do check in before the table is designated to close (depends on the type of tournament).

 Your handicap is usually going to be taken from the first of the month so if you have an issue please let me know but don't discuss it in detail at the check in. I will repair any discrepancies by the end of the day.

Most of you do a pretty good job with these things but a few of you need help! Notice I didn't ask you to be neat! I know asking for that would be like trying to poke hot butter up a wildcats asshole with an ice pick, but I considered it!
