### Clergy Column

Ephphetha! This is the strange word we hear in today's Gospel. Jesus says to the deaf and mute man, "Ephphetha!—Open up!" and the man was miraculously healed. He could hear and speak without impediment. The Ephphetha ceremony is one of the smaller rites that most people don't even notice happening at a Baptism. Before the baby is baptized the priest repeats this gesture first modeled by Christ. It is done after the priest has presented the Easter Candle to the father or godfather so that he may light the Baptismal Candle from it. As the priest touches the ears and mouth of the one who has just been baptized, and says, "The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak. May he soon touch your ears to received his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father." It is a beautiful blessing that reminds everyone that the baptized are called to spread our faith to others.

Thank you to all who have Masses offered on behalf of friends and family. I have offered Masses for almost all of the stipends I have received, and now I am running out. This would be an opportune time to have Masses said for those in need. # 7th-12th Grade Religious Education

I have been getting ready for another year of religious education with your children in grades 7-12. Once again, I will be teaching them two Wednesday evenings a month (7:15-8:30) at St. Francis Xavier Church in Oklee. Our first class is on **October 10<sup>th</sup>**. In our classes last year we worked our way through the Catechism of the Catholic Church as we studied each of the 7 Sacraments in detail. This year we will continue with our focus on the Catechism, as we dive into Morality. There are a number of urgent moral dilemmas that teens face every day, and my aim this year is to prepare your teen to make wise and holy choices in his or her life.

## 12th Grade Confirmation Preparation

For students in 12<sup>th</sup> grade, this will be an important year, because they will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, which will impart on them an indelible character, seal them with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and fully initiate them into the Catholic Church. Because of the importance that we place on this Sacrament, extra effort and sacrifices will be required of them this year. There is a mandatory **Parent and Student meeting** for 12<sup>th</sup>-grade students and their parents on **October 3rd**, at 7:15 p.m. at St. Ann's Church in Goodridge. At this meeting, I will explain the requirements to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and I will give you important dates for the upcoming year.

I look forward to working with all the kids in our parish this year. Once again, our first general R.E. class for all 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders is on October 10<sup>th</sup> in Oklee, where the students will receive a calendar of events, deadlines, and class sessions at that time. The meeting just for 12<sup>th</sup> graders and their parents is on October 3<sup>rd</sup> in Goodridge. May God bless you!
