RECITAL ROUTINES

The recital fee is due with the April autopay that runs on April 5. The \$25 recital fee is per dancer and covers rehearsal time at the Kuss Auditorium, routine notes, chaperone fee, and the recital souvenir. We will be uploading your recital music to DropBox and will email the link to you so you can access your dancer's music. If you would prefer a CD, please email your request to Miss Kelly.

Remember, our annual recital this year will be Saturday, June 16 and the mandatory dress rehearsal will be Friday, June 15, all at Kuss Auditorium in Springfield.


