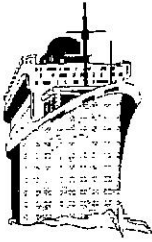

Congratulations Parrot Heads!!!

Our efforts to support the relocation of SAM-
SON to the Orange County Zoo appear to have been
successful. VICKI EBERSOL at Supervisor
Vasquez's office informed me this week that plans
are moving forward to bring SAMSON back to
Southern California. She said that their office re-
ceived an overwhelming number of telephone calls
in favor of the plan and only two calls against. Lest
you think a simple phone call isn't important to a
politician Ms. Ebersol went to great length to ex-
plain how plans were almost halted because one of
the negative callers also wrote an editorial to the
O.C. REGISTER. However, the overwhelming sup-
port was in favor of planned expenditure. Several
corporate sponsors such as HOME DEPOT also
gave their support by volunteering some of the
building materials and other sponsors offering to
supply the labor. The COUNTY will then provide a
matching amount from the Urban Parks fund. SAM-
SON will stay in Sacramento or possibly the L.A.
Zoo until his habitat is constructed.

SUPPORT.

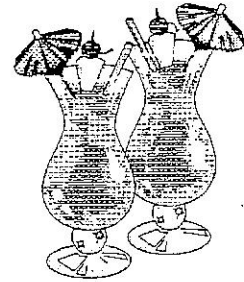
Boat Drinks

BOAT DRINKS! Waitress I need two More BOAT DRINKS....

Coral Reef A frozen drink that looks as cool as it's name

a jigger of rum
shot of lemon juice
shot of simple syrup
half a shot of grenadine
scoop of crushed ice



Combine Rum, lemon juice, syrup, grenadine, and ice in a blender until smooth.
Serve in a martini glass and garnish with a flower.

Jolly Mon Everyone has had it and it has a gazillion names but it's usually rum & coconut

jigger of dark rum
jigger of Coconut liqueur
jigger of coconut milk or cream
Mix it up and serve it over crushed ice.
Garnish with shredded coconut.

Perfect Margarita Jell-o (well maybe not a drink)

Lime jell-o mix according to instructions but instead of one cup cold water add:
4 oz. cuervo 1800
1 oz. Bols Triple Sec (Nothin' but the best)

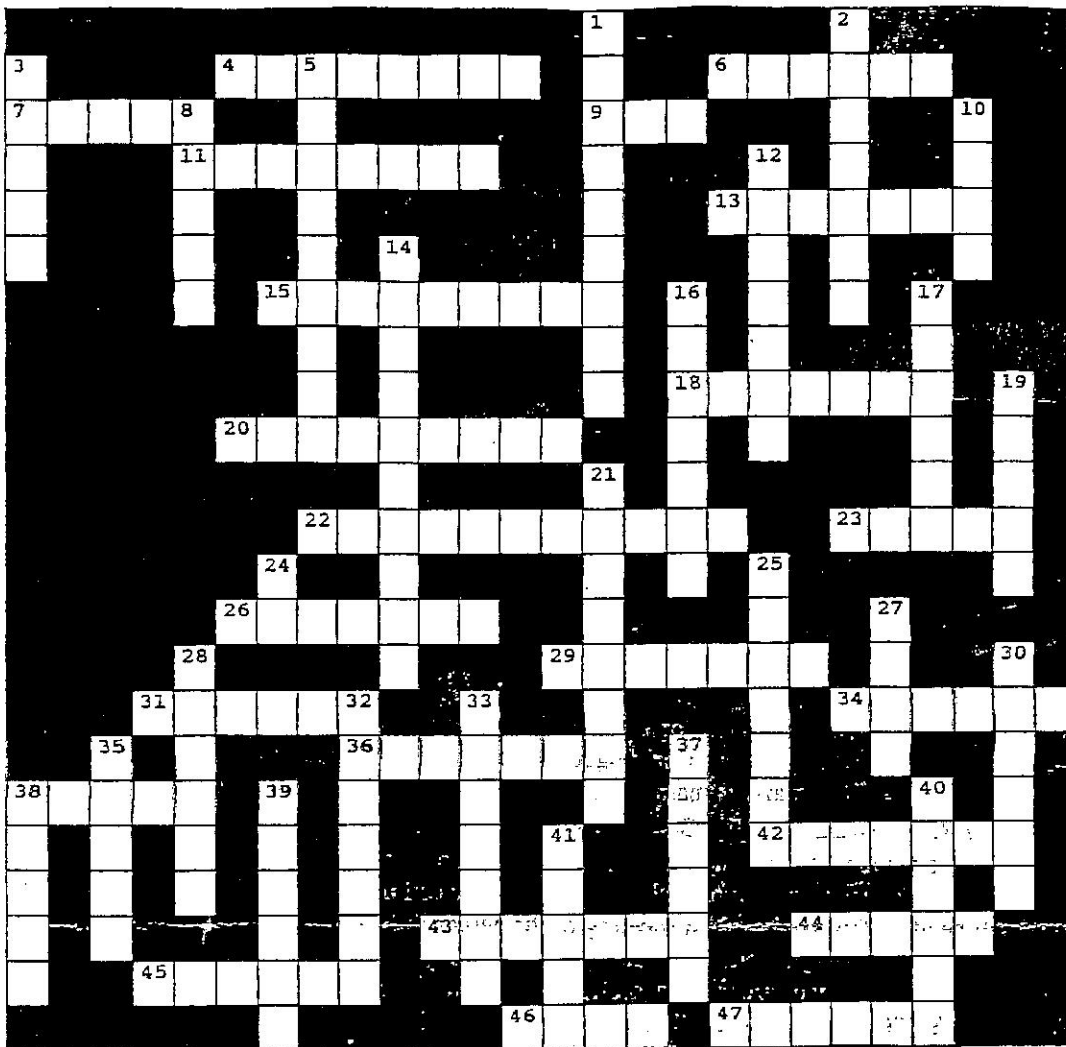

Fireside Chat (a note from the Prez.)

In June of this year, a handful of us decided we'd like to join the local chapter of the JIMMY BUFFETT Parrot Head Clubs, Nationally known as Parrot Heads in Paradise. I don't think we need very much structure but if we all work together and exchange ideas, I think it can be a lot of fun. WE NEED HELP!!! 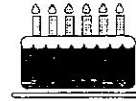
