How is the WHJBSL responding to the current Coronavirus pandemic?

The Board of the Wichita Heights Jr. Baseball Softball League recognizes the growing health concerns for families regarding the Coronavirus/COVID-19 health pandemic.

The 7 districts that make up the WHJBSL are currently following the latest recommendation of the CDC by refraining from any large in-person gatherings for at least 8 weeks.

We continue to consult with state & local health professionals to help guide our decisions, and we pledge to follow their recommendations before starting any league play.

Our highest priority remains the health, safety, & well-being of our players and families.

Will our kids be able to play baseball or softball in the WHJBSL this summer?

We certainly hope so, and that is our GOAL!

We are fully committed to providing a safe program for our kids this summer, if at all possible.

In fact, the Board recently voted to continue the planning process for the upcoming season.

Together, the Board has discussed and decided on the following course of action:

1. Practices to begin sometime around June 1st
2. We will most likely play a modified game schedule
3. Targeted end date of July 17th

Please note that this plan of action is subject to change as we receive new information from our health professionals at the CDC & KDHE, as well as our local public officials.

The next WHJBSL Board meeting is April 22nd & we will provide updates after that meeting.
